 - The Helmet of Salvation




The Weapons of Spiritual Warfare

- The Sword of the Spirit, Which is the Word of God
 - The instruction manual of warfare
 - The weapon of defense and offense
- Prayer
 - The call for backup
 - The humble recognition for the need of help

- In Prayer we obtain the strength of His Might.
Ephesians 6:10 Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor....
- We pray at all times, because the war is constant and battles may strike at any moment.
- We use every form of prayer: adoration, confession, intercession, thanksgiving, etc.
- We implore God with specific requests (petition) for our battles.



18^b To that end keep alert with all perseverance,
making supplication for all the saints,

- Prayer Keeps us alert of the Warfare and Battles.
 - It keeps us alert cracks in the armor.
 - It keeps us alert of Satan's darts
- Prayer is the means of putting the armor on and keeping it on (perseverance).
- Through prayer the Spirit informs us when we need to put on the helmet, take up the Shield of Faith and the Sword for Battle.

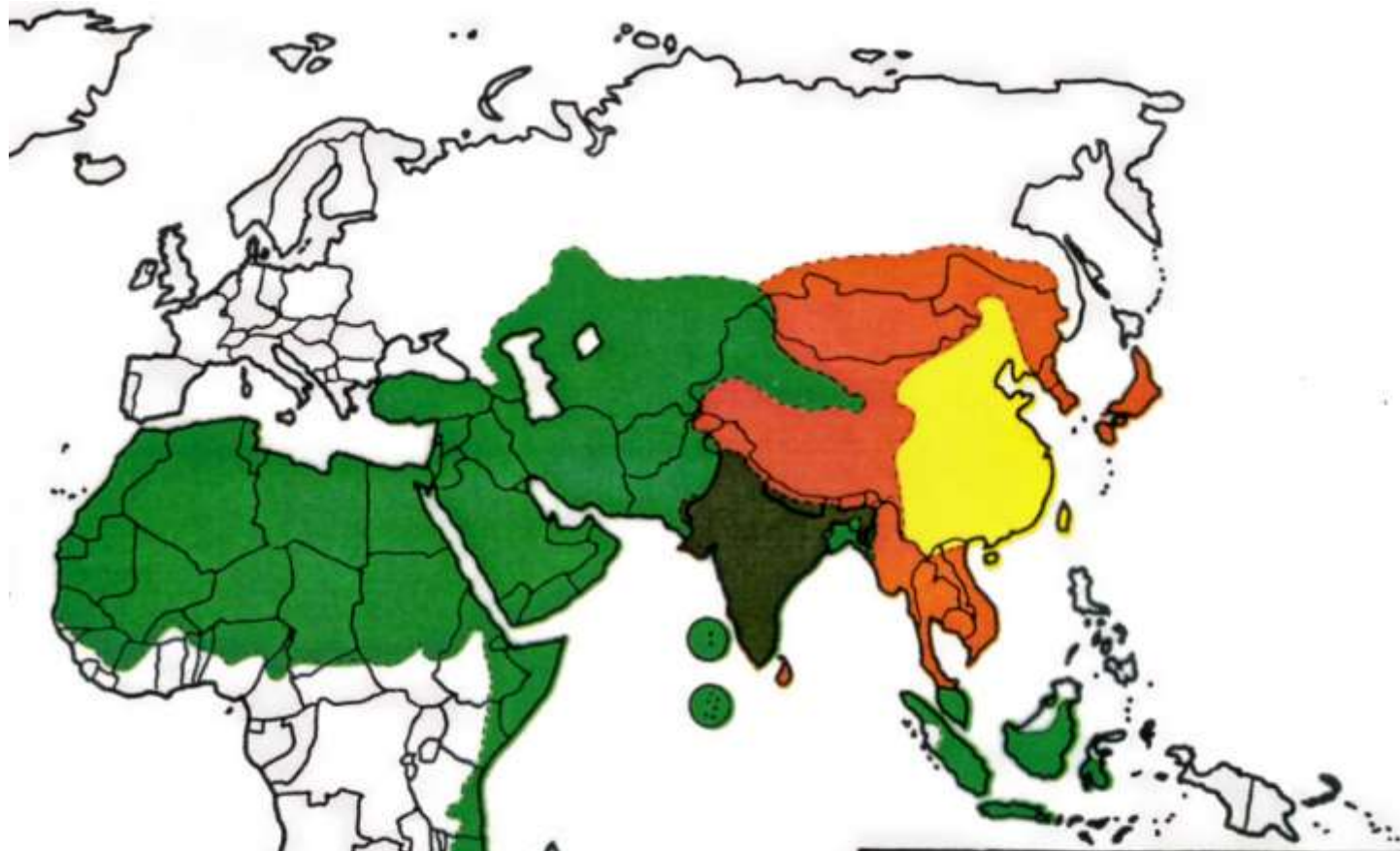

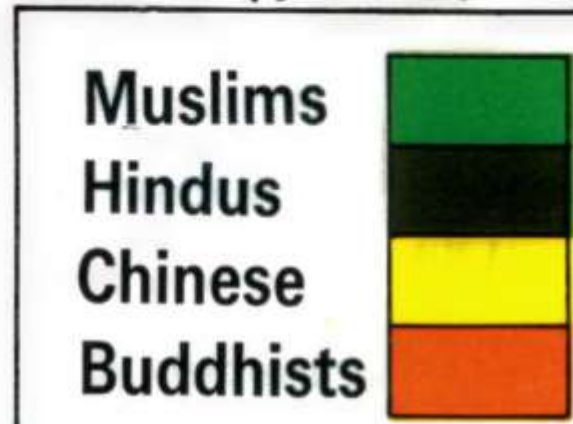
