An assembly for worship

1 Corinthians 11:18 For first of all, when you come together as a church, I hear that there are divisions among you, and in part I believe it.

The group of believers that meet together 1 Corinthians 1:2 To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:

The group of believers that meet together 1 Thessalonians 1:1a Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians

Philemon 1:2b and to the church in your house:

The world-wide body of saints **Ephesians 5:23** For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. Matthew 16:18 And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall

not prevail against it.

Which church do you belong to ?

- How would 1st century Christians answer ?
- They would answer with location –
- Corinth, Ephesus, Philippi, etc.
- NEVER a denomination
- NEVER a building

ekklesia

- **Ek** out of, from
- Klesia (from kaleo) to call
- Literal called out or called out ones

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

In NT times used as :

An called, planned meeting, city council -

Acts 19:39 But if you have any other inquiry to make, it shall be determined in the lawful <u>assembly (ekklesia)</u>.

- In NT times used as :
- A special people, a called out group
- **Galatians 1:6** I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who <u>called you</u> in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel,
- **Ephesians 4:4** There is one body and one Spirit, just as <u>you were called</u> in one hope of your calling;

- In NT times used as :
- A special people, a called out group
- **Colossians 3:15** And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also <u>you were called</u> in one body; and be thankful.
- **1 Thessalonians 2:12** that you would walk worthy of God who <u>calls you</u> into His own kingdom and glory.

Not a building of sticks and bricks

Ephesians 2:20 having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief corner stone,

1 Peter 2:9a But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people

What Jesus built

- Jesus did not build Peter's church
- Jesus is the only foundation

1 Corinthians 3:11 For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.
