What's really important?

- Misplaced Priorities brings God's judgment
 - Haggai 1:1-15

Refocusing our Priorities

Haggai – a prophet sent to warn the people

 Could you have wrong Priorities and have the wrong focus?

Too busy working and raising a family?

Consequences:

Frustration! – Never really satisfied

There's a cause to their problems

Nothing was working out for them

Sound like anyone you know?

 Forgotten or Neglected Priorities also brings God's judgment

- Luke 12:19-21

The Solution: Be humble and obey. Josh 1:8

God resists the Proud – 1 Peter 5:5

 "To him that knows to do good, and does it not, to him it is sin" – James 4:17

- They rededicated themselves to God
- God stirred their hearts and empowered them

- Their Priorities were wrong!
 - The people focused on their wants and desires
 - God touched their pocketbooks
 - They had money problems

 Let's examine some financial Priorities found in the Bible

Here's a Principled System



- Five timeless truths to provide a structure on which to "hang" concepts
- Helps decision process become sequential
- Gives principled guidelines on handling 100% of my money

Timeless truth #1

- God is a God of order, sequence and priority
 - Gen 1
 - -I Cor 14:40
 - **-Proverbs 24:27**

- Timeless truth #2
- The family is the foundation stone of God's plan for mankind
 - -Gen 2
 - -I Tim 5:8
 - Deut. 6:4ff

- Timeless truth #3
- God wants our life choices to bring glory to Him
 - -Gen 6 Numbers
 - -I Cor 10:31
 - -I Pet 2:15

Timeless truth #4


- God wants His people to help those who are less fortunate
 - -Ex Deut: Levitical, festival, charity
 - -James 2:15-17
 - -I John 3:17-18

- God wants to bless His people who obey
 - Deut 6 8
 - -I Tim 6:17
 - -Rev 21:7

Application #1 - Giving

- Returning to the Lord that which is His is the FIRST financial priority and privilege
 - Prov 3:9
 - Lev 27:30
 - II Cor 8:5

- Remember;
 - "God is a God of order, sequence and priority"

Tithing isn't the ceiling of giving; it's the floor. It's not the finish line of giving; it's just the starting blocks.

Tithes can be the training wheels to launch us into the mind-set, skills, and habits of grace giving.

Ironically, many people can't afford to give precisely because they're not giving (Haggai 1:9-11).

If we pay our debt to God first, then we will incur His blessing to help us pay our debts to men.

Application #2 - Saving

- Setting aside to protect one's family is the SECOND financial priority and privilege
 - Pr 21:20
 - Pr 15:6
 - I Tim 5:8

- Remember
 - "The family is the foundation stone of God's plan for mankind"

Application #3 — Spending

- Being timely, honest and just with creditors is the THIRD financial priority and privilege
 - -Ps 37:21
 - -Rom 13:7a
 - -I Thes 4:11-12

- Remember
 - "God wants our life choices to bring glory to Him"

Application #4 - Offerings

- Being mindful and generous towards the needs of others is the FOURTH financial priority and privilege
 - -Gal 2:10
 - -I Cor 16:2-3
 - -II Cor 8:14

- Remember
 - "God wants
 His people to
 help those
 who are less
 fortunate"

Don't be Stingy

God says, "If a man shuts his ears to the cry of the poor, he too will cry out and not be answered" (Proverbs 21:13).

In Isaiah 58:6-10, God says that His willingness to answer our prayers is directly affected by whether we are caring for the hungry, needy, and oppressed. Want to empower your prayer life? Give.

Purpose of Prosperity:

God prospers me not to raise my standard of living, but to raise my standard of giving.

Application #5 - Luxuries

- Rightfully enjoying God's faithful provision is the FIFTH priority and privilege
 - -Job 42:12
 - -I Tim 6:17
 - -I Cor 4:7


- Remember
