

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS




- 2 TO 6 WEEKS AFTER INFECTIONS SORES BECOMES PAINLESS NEAR GENITALS ANUS OR MOUTH BUT GOES AWAY
- 3 TO 6 WEEKS AFTER SORES APPEARS RASH ON YOUR HANDS FEET OTHER PARTS OF YOUR BODY AND THEY COME AND GO OVER 1 – 2 YEARS


TREATMENT


IT CAN BE CURED WITH ANTIBIOTICS



Signs and Symptoms


- FEMALE –


- SHORT TERMS-


GONORRHEA

SIGNS AND SYPTOMS


- Discharge from penis vagina or rectum

RESULTS


- Damage to joints, heart, and the brain

TREATMENT




- Antibiotics
