THANKFUL TO THE LORD



WHY GOD REVEALS THINGS TO COME?

- He does that to prepare us for what is coming.
- To cause us to intercede in prayer to prevent or to change a situation.
- Prophet Isaiah to king Hezekiah saying: Put your house in order because you soon will die, the King was fervent in prayer and he was healed and granted 15 more years of life.
- Remember God speaking with Abraham about Sodom and Gomorra?
- Or Abraham, Sarah and King Abimelech?
- That is why He reveals His secrets!
- Get ready! His secrets are on your way. You are His friend aren't you?
