Greek - NT - Tartarus 2 times Hell – 1 time – deep pit, abyss 2 Peter 2:4 For if God did not spare the angels who sinned, but cast them down to hell and delivered them into chains of darkness, to be reserved for judgment;



Greek – NT – Gehenna 12 times Hell – the place of eternal fire, eternal punishement "The term Gehenna arose from the valley of Hinnom, south of Jerusalem, where the Canaanites burned human sacrifices to Moloch."

Greek - NT - Gehenna "After the return of the Jews from the captivity they made it a place of defilement, where the refuse of the city was thrown and burned. The name was applied to the place of future punishement by the Jews."

Greek - NT - Gehenna 12 times in the New Testament 1 time Jesus did not use the word James 3:6 And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire by hell.

Greek - NT - Gehenna 12 times in the New Testament 1 time Jesus was in a private setting Matthew 10:28 And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.
