

## MOSES THE PRINCE OF EGYPT

- The Hebrew name "MOSES" is given to him by the Pharaoh's daughter because she said, "I pulled him out of the water."
- is a prophet in Abrahamic religions.
- According to the Hebrew Bible, he was a former Egyptian prince who later in life became a religious leader and lawgiver, to whom the authorship of the Torah is traditionally attributed.
- Also called "Moshe Rabbenu" in Hebrew.








