**Transliterated "GOD" or "LORD" in OT** 

God's personal name

# El-Shaddai God Almighty

Transliterated "Almighty" in OT

Whenever you see "Almighty" in the OT, it is El-Shaddai (48x)

#### Adoni Lord/Master

**Transliterated "Lord" in OT** 

Remember, Adoni is "Lord" and Jehovah is "LORD" in KJB

### Jehovah-Jireh The LORD will provide

"And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovah-Jireh: as it is said to this day, in the mount of the Lord it shall be seen." (Gen. 22:14)

#### Jehovah-Rophe The LORD Who heals

"...for I am the LORD that healeth thee." (Exo. 15:26)

#### Jehovah-Nissi The LORD our banner

The battle is the Lord's. We have no hope for victory without His power. The ultimate portrayal of Jehovah-Nissi is Christ paying the wages for our sins on a cross. (See John 3:14-16)

# Jehovah M'Kaddesh The LORD Which Sanctify You

# Jehovah Tsidkenu The LORD Our Righteousness

# Jehovah Rohi The LORD My Shepherd

Rohi means to "tend a flock," which includes meeting the needs of the individual sheep.
