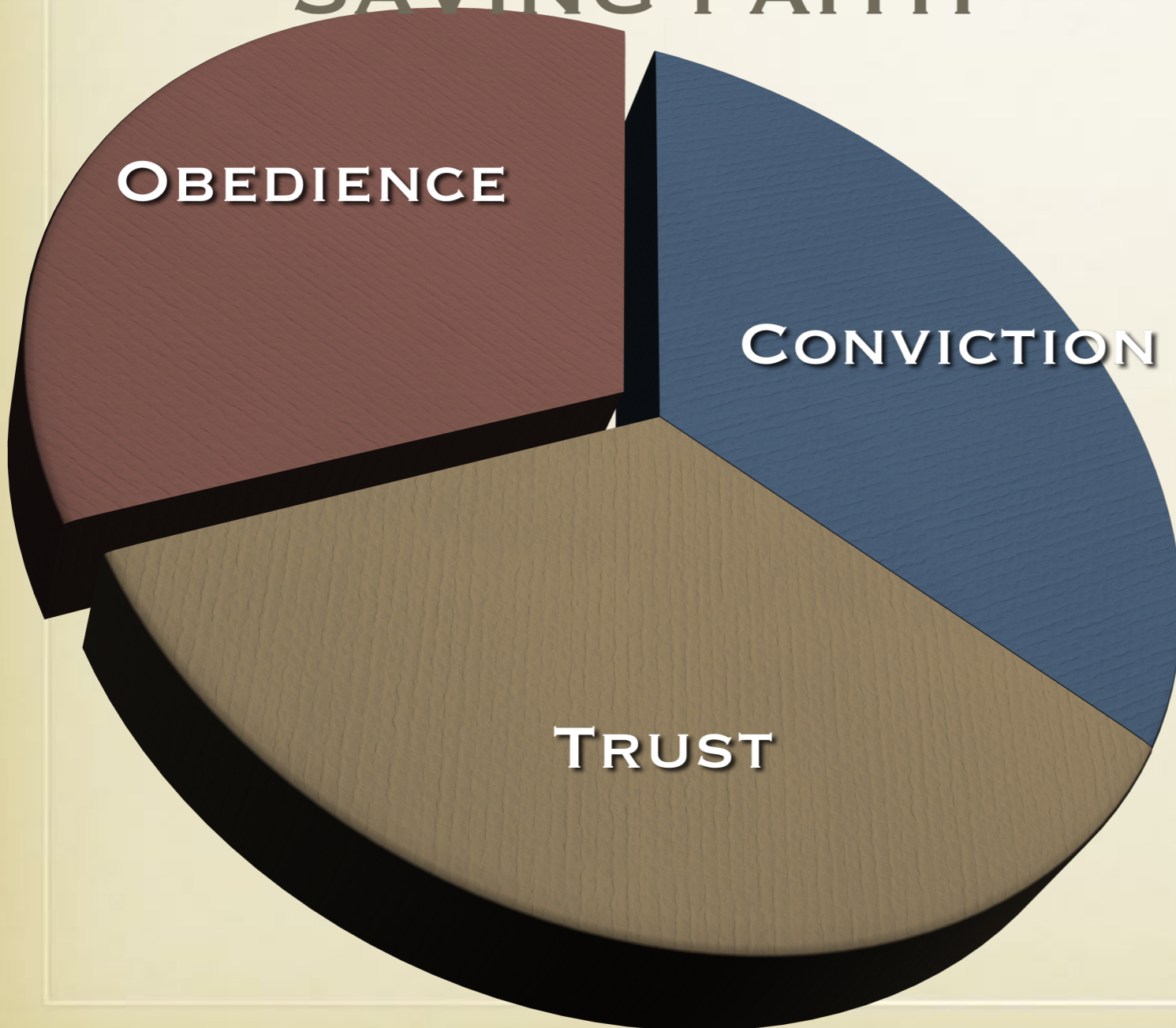

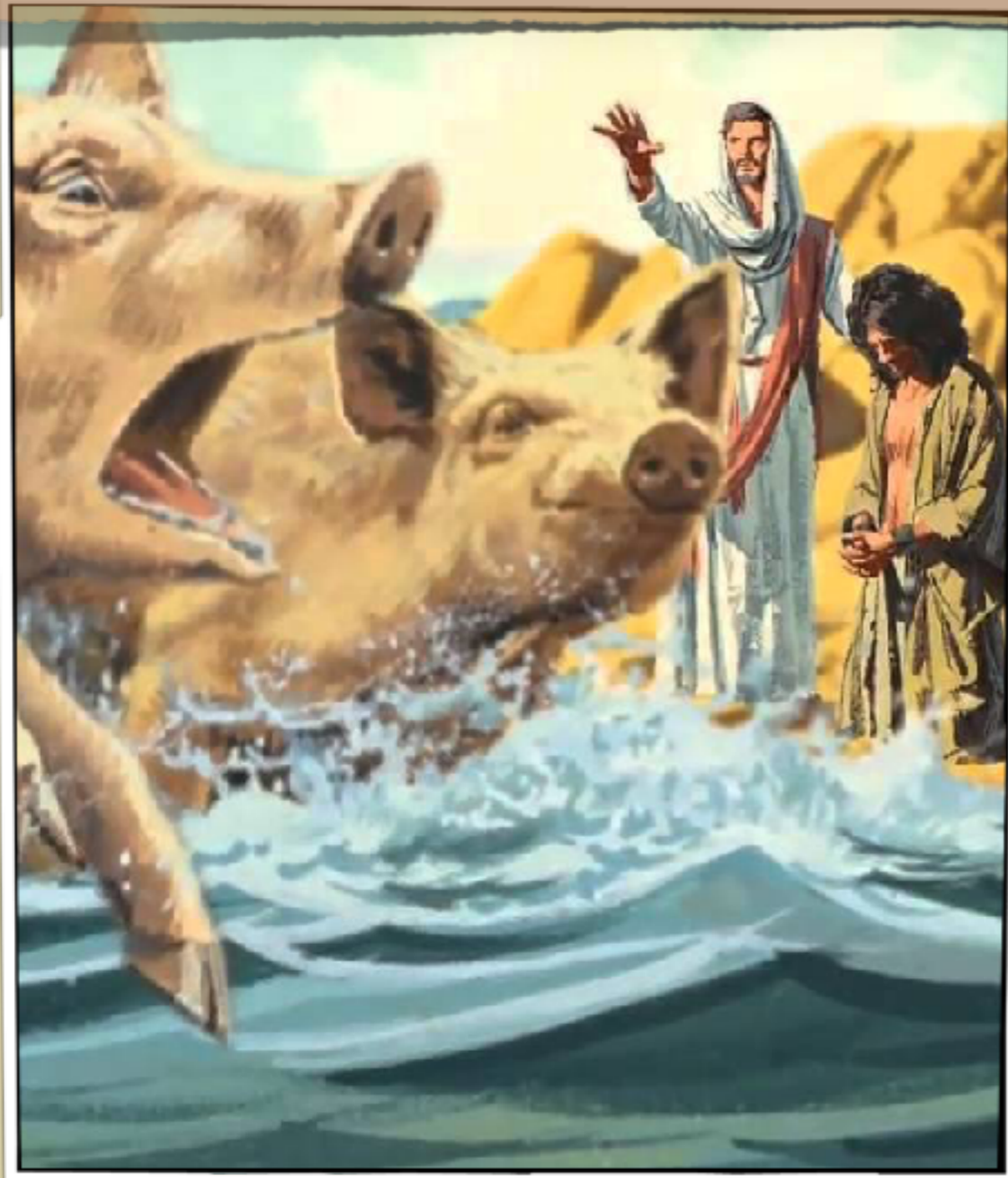

# *The* **NATURE** *of* **SAVING FAITH**

Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH

## ROMANS 10:1-7 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. <sup>2</sup> For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. <sup>3</sup> For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. <sup>4</sup> For Christ *is* the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.



# *The* **NATURE** *of* **SAVING FAITH**

Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH

## ROMANS 10:1-7 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> For Moses writes about the righteousness which is of the law, “*The man who does those things shall live by them.*” <sup>6</sup> But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, “*Do not say in your heart, ‘Who will ascend into heaven?’*” (that is, to bring Christ down *from above*) <sup>7</sup> or, “*Who will descend into the abyss?*” (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). – [Deut 30:12-14]



# The **NATURE** of **SAVING FAITH**

## Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH

### of The **LAW**

ROMANS 10:1-13

### of The **FAITH**

- LOST - 1
- ZEAL for God without knowledge - 2; Jn 5:46
- Ignorantly sought to establish own righteousness - 3
- Had NOT submitted to the righteousness of God - 3
- The Law CANNOT save - 5; 7:10; Gal 3:10-12



- "Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes." - 4; 8:3,4; Mat. 5:17,18; Gal. 3:24-29
- God provides what we COULD NOT provide for ourselves - 7; Jn 3:16
- This message has been preached - MUST believe in Jesus - 8-11

Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH

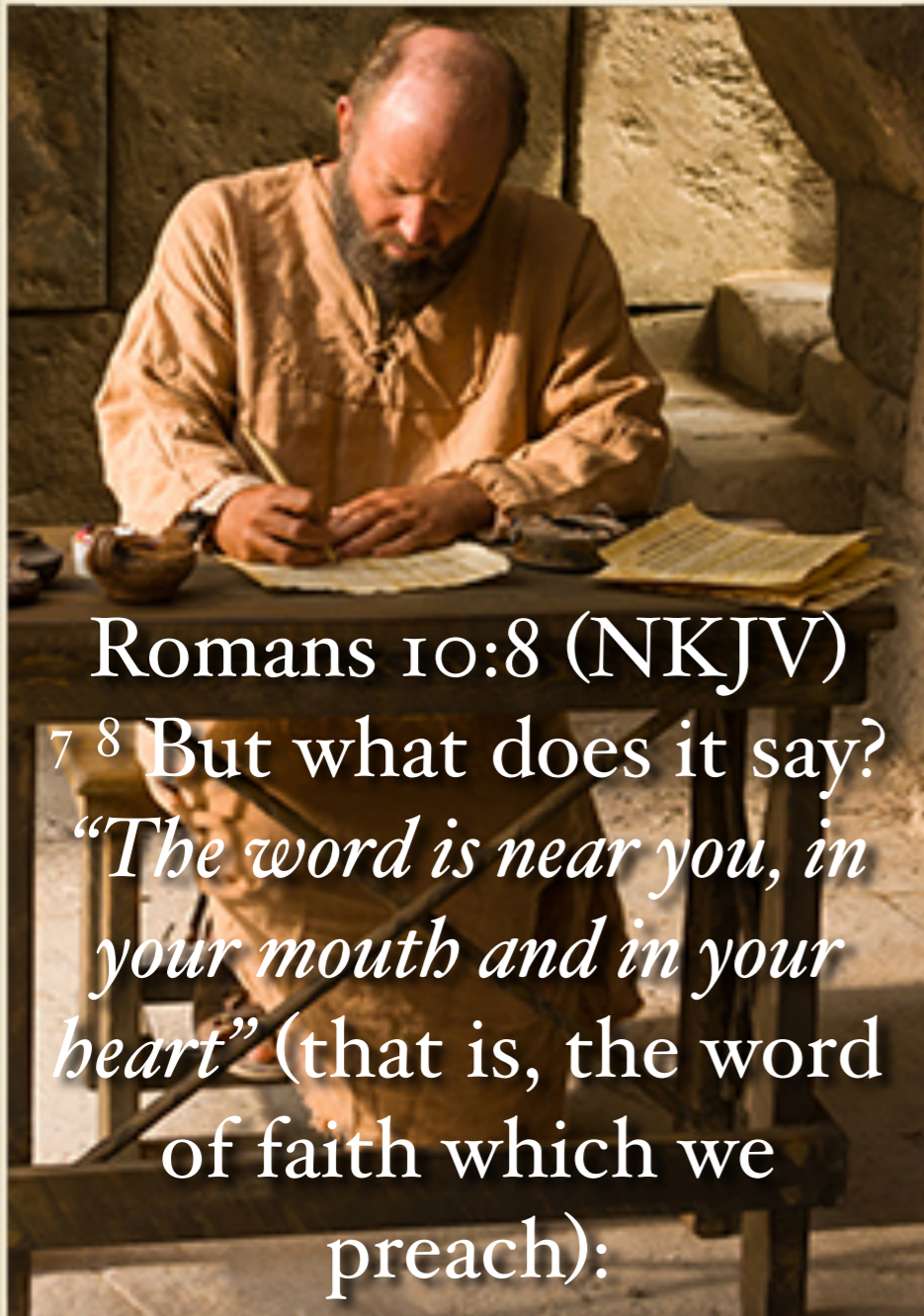
## ROMANS 10:8-11 (NKJV)

<sup>8</sup> But what does it say? *“The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart”* (that is, the word of faith which we preach): <sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. <sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, *“Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.”*



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH



- Confess with the mouth - (9,10) – Mat 10:32,33; Luke 12:8; 1 John 4:2,3; Acts 8:38; Jn 9:22; 12:42,43
- Believe in your heart (9,10) – John 3:16; 8:24; Acts 8:37
- Will be saved / unto righteousness / unto salvation (9,10) – **salvation – righteousness is not attained at the point of faith**, – Jn 1:12; Mark 16:16; Gal. 3:26,27
- Not be ashamed (11) – Is. 28:16



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH

## ROMANS 10:12-17 (NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. <sup>13</sup> For “*whoever calls* on the name of the Lord shall be saved.” <sup>14</sup> How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?



# *The* **NATURE** *of* **SAVING FAITH**

Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH


## ROMANS 10:12-17 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: *“How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!”* <sup>16</sup> But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, “Lord, who has believed our report?” <sup>17</sup> So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## Righteousness of WORKS vs. Righteousness of FAITH



Romans 10:12-13  
(NKJV)

<sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. <sup>13</sup> For “*whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.*”

- No distinction between Jew and Gentile - (12) – Rom. 1:16,17; 3:22,29,30; 4:11,12; 9:24
- Same Lord over all (12) – Acts 2:36; 15:11; Eph. 2:14-22
- Is rich to all who call upon Him, for “*whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved*” - (12,13) – Joel 2:32; Acts 2:21;
- What does it mean to call upon the name of the Lord?



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

The Gospel God's Power to SAVE All Who Believe - Romans

Romans 10:13-18

Calling on the name of the LORD and **obeying the gospel** are equivalent phrases.

How can they call? (13,14)

They have not all obeyed the gospel (16)

Must BELIEVE (14)

Must hear (14)

Preaching (14,15)

Did NOT believe (16)

Heard (17,18)

Preached (18)





# The **NATURE** of **SAVING FAITH**

HOW DO WE CALL UPON THE NAME OF  
THE LORD? - **Acts 2:14-42**

“whoever calls on the  
name of the Lord Shall  
be saved.” - Acts 2:21;  
(Joel 2:32)

Peter preaches Jesus &  
proclaims Him to be  
**LORD & CHRIST** -  
Acts 2:22-36

<sup>37</sup> ... “Men *and*  
brethren, what  
shall we do?”

Acts 2:38 (NKJV)

<sup>38</sup> Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every  
one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for  
the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift  
of the Holy Spirit.



# The **NATURE** of **SAVING FAITH**

HOW DO WE CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD? - **Acts 22:14-42**

Paul sees Jesus ... “go to Damascus ... be told what to do” - Acts 22:6-11

Paul **PRAYED & FASTED** for three days - Acts 9:9-11

Ananias sent to Paul to tell him what he must do - Acts 9:6, 10-18; 22:10-16

Acts 22:16 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

HOW DO WE CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD? - **1 Peter 3:21**

As Noah was saved in the ark by water, Baptism SAVES us.  
(20)

Not a ceremonial cleansing - not a fleshly ritual - Hebrews 9:9,10

An appeal to God for a good conscience - Hebrews 9:11-15; 10:22; Col. 2:11-13

1 Peter 3:21 (ESV)

<sup>21</sup> Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?



Matthew 28:19–20 (NKJV)

<sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age.” Amen.



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?



Mark 16:15–16 (NKJV)

<sup>15</sup> And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. <sup>16</sup>

He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?

Acts 2:38-41 (NKJV)

<sup>38</sup> Then Peter said to them, “Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. . . .

<sup>41</sup> Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added *to them*. (vs 47)

# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?



Romans 6:3–5 (NKJV)

<sup>3</sup> Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? <sup>4</sup> Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. <sup>5</sup> For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be *in the likeness of His* resurrection,



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?



Galatians 3:26–29 (NKJV)

<sup>26</sup> For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. <sup>27</sup> For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. <sup>28</sup> There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is neither male nor female; for you are all one in Christ Jesus. <sup>29</sup> And if you *are* Christ's, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.



# The NATURE of SAVING FAITH

## WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?



Colossians 2:11–13 (NKJV)

<sup>11</sup> In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, <sup>12</sup> buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with *Him* through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. <sup>13</sup> And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,
