


HEBREWS 11 / By FAITH ...

ROMANS 10:1-7 (NKJV)

¹ Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. ² For I bear them witness that they have a zeal for God, but not according to knowledge. ³ For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. 4 For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.

ROMANS 10:1-7 (NKJV) ⁵ For Moses writes about the righteousness which is of the law, "The man who does those things shall live by them." 6 But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?' " (that is, to bring Christ down from above) 7 or, " 'Who will descend into the abyss?" "(that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). - [Deut 30:12-14]

LOST - 1

- ZEAL for God without knowledge - 2; Jn 5:46
- Ignorantly sought to establish own righteousness 3
- Had NOT submitted to the righteousness of God – 3
- The Law CANNOT save - 5; 7:10; Gal 3:10-12



"Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes." – 4; 8:3,4; Mat. 5:17,18; Gal. 3:24–29

God provides what we COULD NOT provide for ourselves — 7; Jn 3:16

This message has been preached – MUST believe in Jesus – 8–11

ROMANS 10:8-11 (NKJV)

⁸ But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ¹¹ For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."



Romans 10:8 (NKJV) ⁸ But what does it say? *The word is near you, in your mouth and in your beart*" (that is, the word of faith which we preach): Confess with the mouth - (9,10) – Mat 10:32,33; Luke 12:8; 1 John 4:2,3; Acts 8:38; Jn 9:22; 12:42,43

Believe in your heart (9,10) – John 3:16; 8:24; Acts 8:37

Will be saved / unto righteousness / unto salvation (9,10) - salvation righteousness is not attained at the point of faith, - Jn 1:12; Mark 16:16; Gal. 3:26,27

➢ Not be ashamed (11) − Is. 28:16

ROMANS 10:12-17 (NKJV) ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. 13 For "whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." 14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher?

ROMANS 10:12-17 (NKJV) ¹⁵ And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, Who bring glad tidings of good things!" 16 But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" 17 So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Romans 10:12-13 (NKJV) ¹² For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. ¹³ For "whoever alls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." No distinction between Jew and Gentile - (12) - Rom. 1:16,17; 3:22,29,30; 4:11,12; 9:24

Same Lord over all (12) – Acts 2:36; 15:11; Eph. 2:14-22

Is rich to all who call upon Him, for "whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be saved" -(12,13) – Joel 2:32; Acts 2:21;

The Gospel God's Power to SAVE All Who Believe - Romans

Romans 10:13-18

How can they call? (13,14) Calling on the name of the LORD and **obeying the gospel** all obeyed the are equivalent phrases. They have not gospel (16)

Must BELIEVE (14)

Must hear (14)

Preaching (14, 15)



Did NOT believe (16)



Preached (18)

HOW DO WE CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD? - Acts 2:14-42

"whoever calls on the name of the Lord Shall be saved." - Acts 2:21; (Joel 2:32) Peter preaches Jesus & proclaims Him to be LORD & CHRIST -Acts 2:22-36

³⁷ …"Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?"

Acts 2:38 (NKJV) ³⁸ Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

HOW DO WE CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD? - Acts 22:14-42

Paul sees Jesus ... "go to Damascus ... be told what to do" - Acts 22:6-11 Paul PRAYED & FASTED for three days - Acts 9:9-11

Ananias sent to Paul to tell him what he must do - Acts 9:6, 10-18; 22:10-16

Acts 22:16 (NKJV) ¹⁶ And now why are you waiting? Arise and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord.


As Noah was saved in the ark by water, Baptism SAVES us. (20) Not a ceremonial cleansing - not a fleshly ritual - Hebrews 9:9,10

An appeal to God for a good conscience -Hebrews 9:11-15; 10:22; Col. 2:11-13

1 Peter 3:21 (ESV)

²¹ Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ,



WHEN DOES FAITH SAVE?




