


# Psalm 8

for him?**

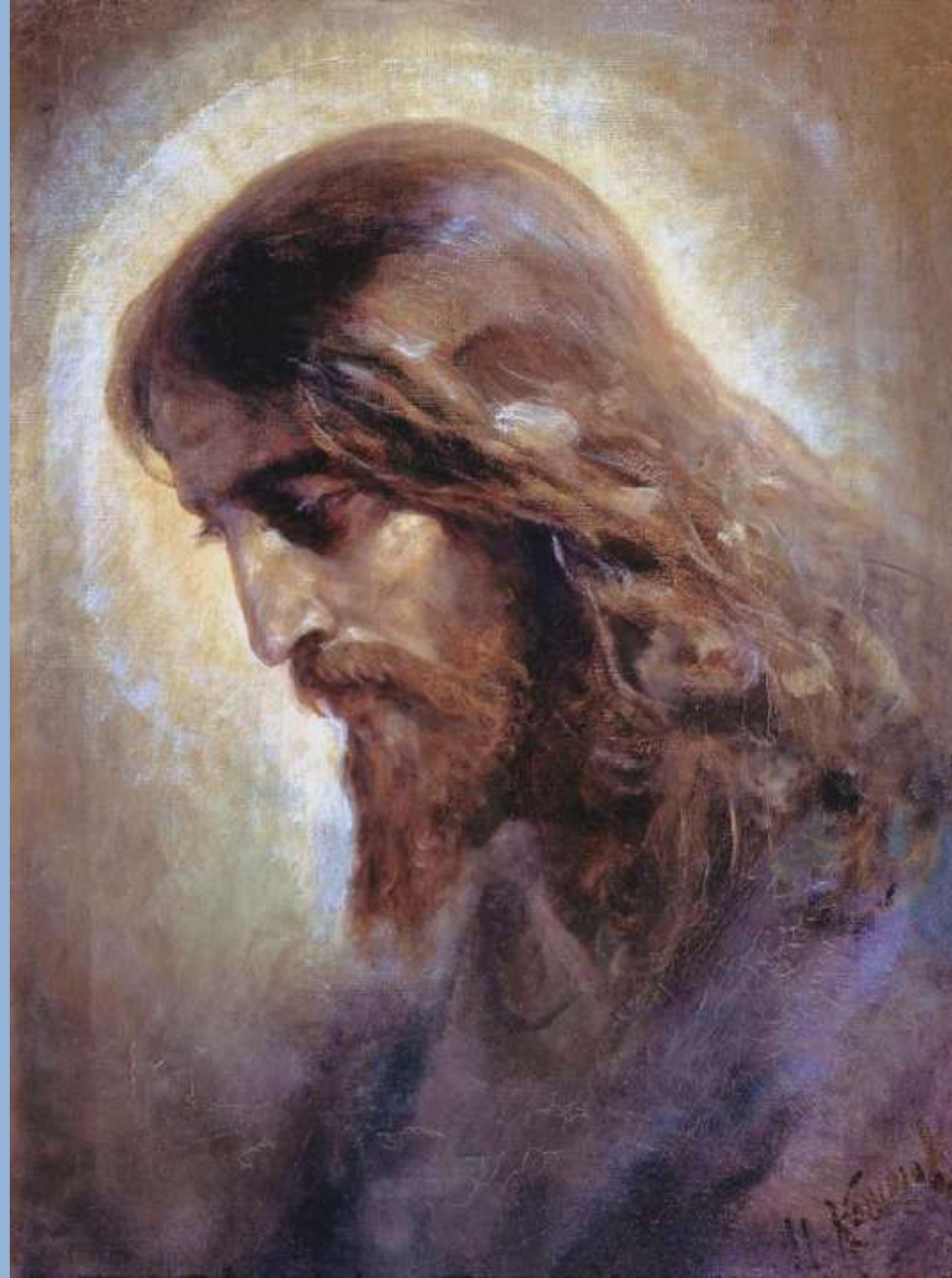


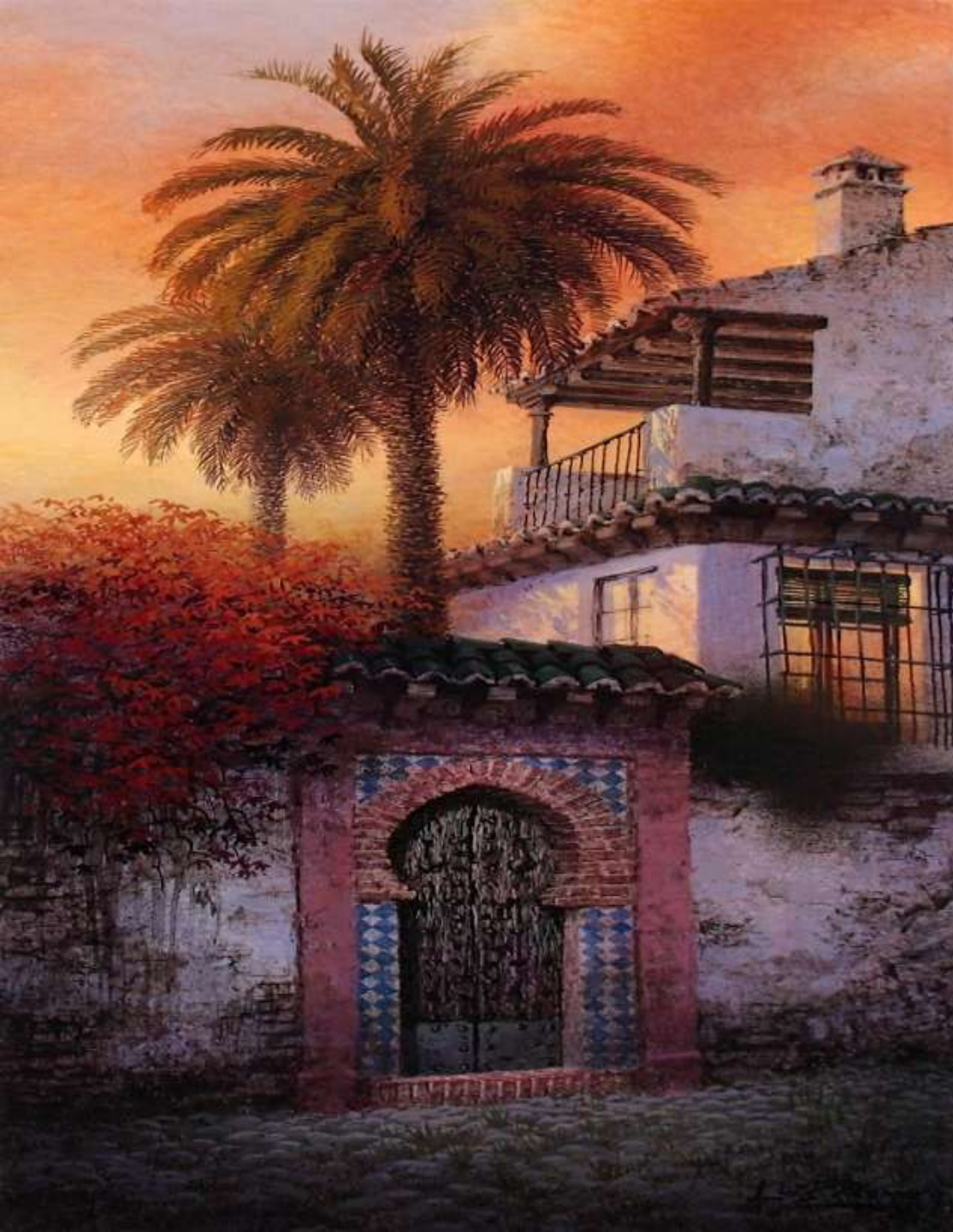

**The birds of the air,**



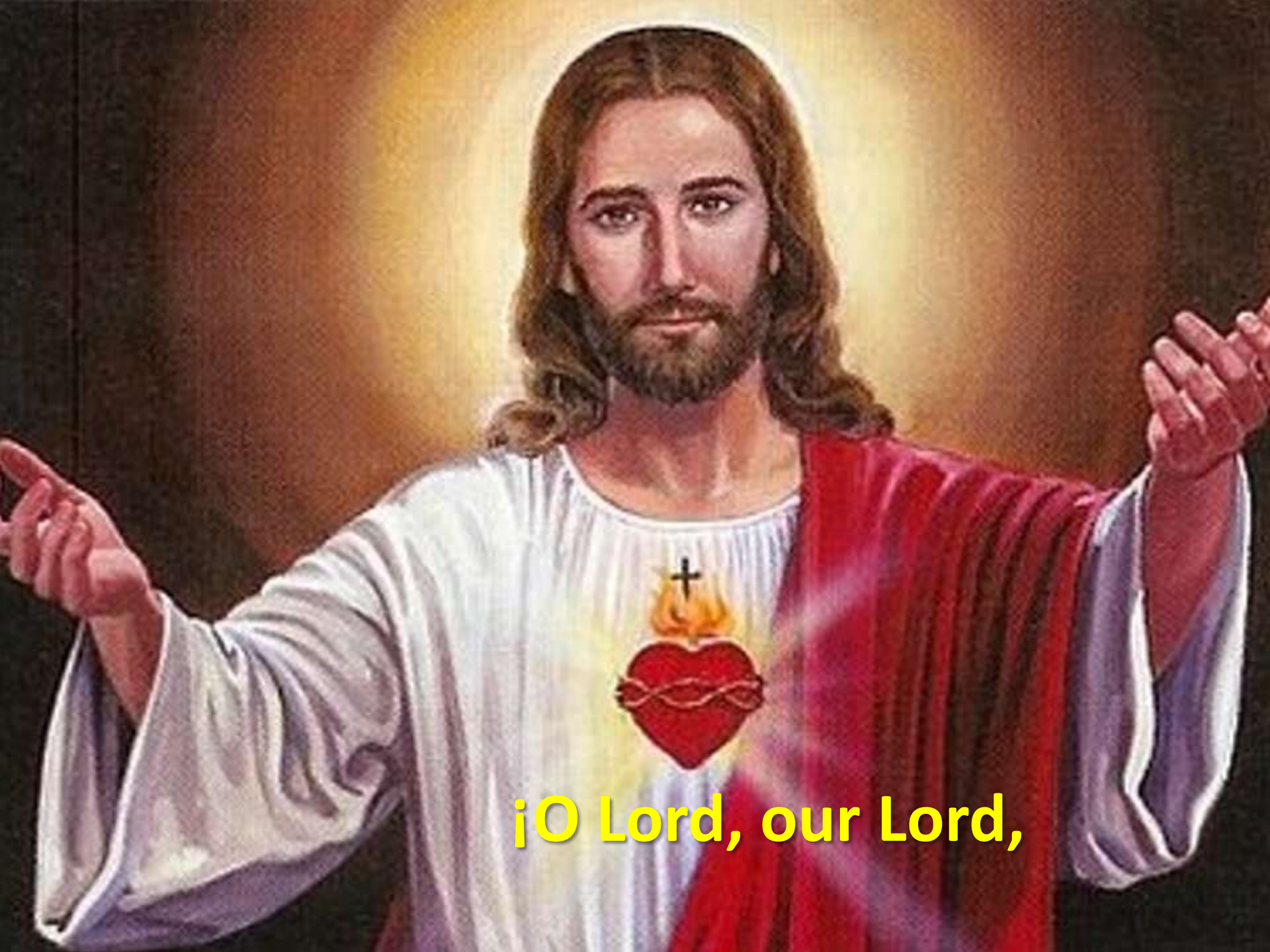
**the fish of the sea,**

the paths of the seas.**







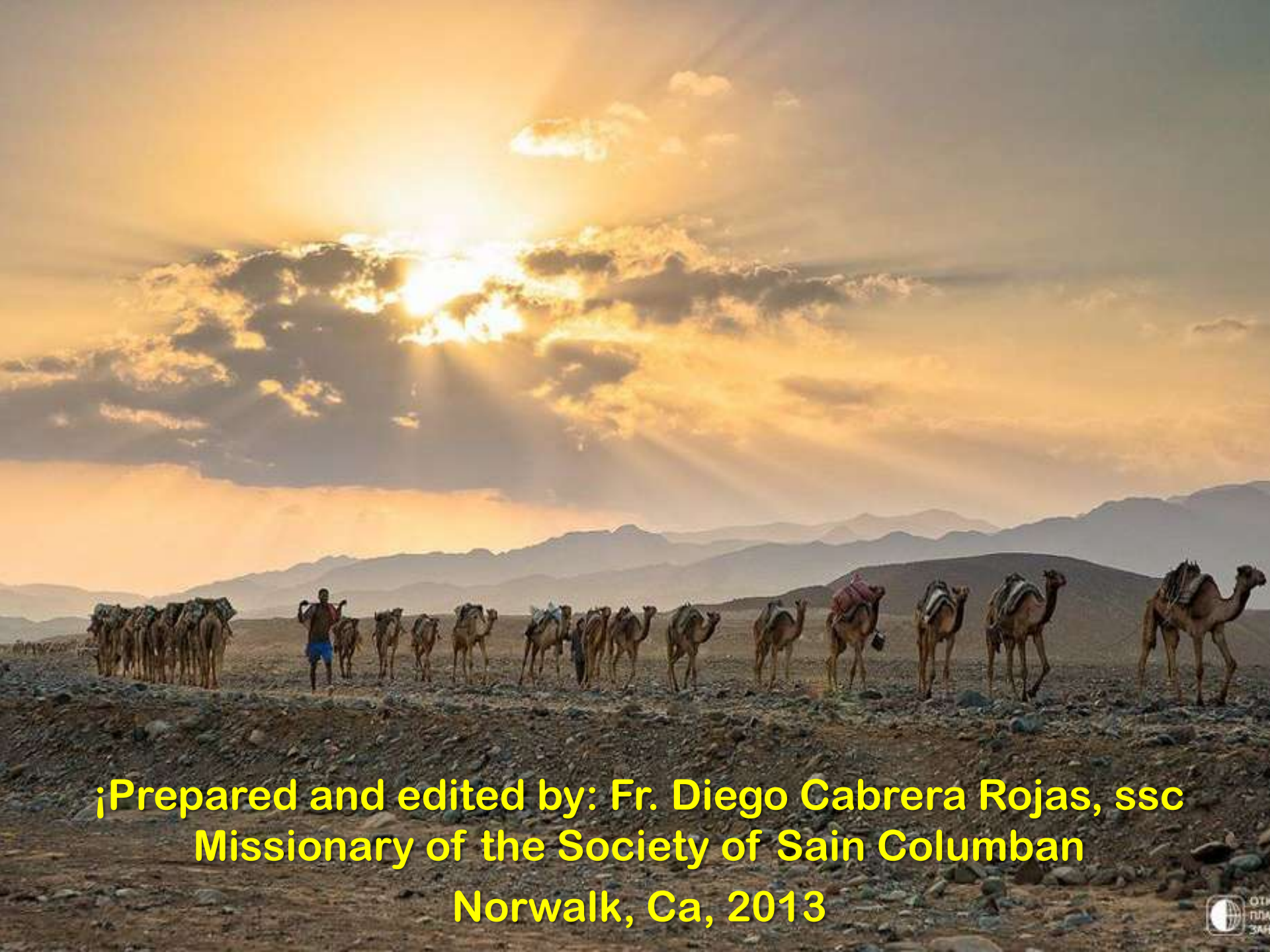
