



# A. God blesses you according to how much you give (2 Cor. 9:6).


"Remember this—a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop" (NLT).

"You must each decide in your heart how much to give" (NLT).




#### The OT Tithe

## Malachi 3:10



# Many Tithe Today...










How come the waitress gets 15% and God only gets 10%?

#### CIC Financials Oct 2009 to Jul 2010






We met the \$7500 budget 2 out of 10 months.




# 3. God increases your ability to give to others (8b-11a).




1. Recipients of gifts realize God alone meets their needs (11b).

C. Others bless God (2 Cor. 9:12b-13).

# The Best Example...


We come into the world with nothing and spend all our days accumulating as much as we can.


