Israel's constant grumbling elicits God's wrath. Israel evaluated God's commands according to their limited perspective, disobeying God and refusing to take the land, condemning an entire generation to death in the desert.

Moses' years of faithful obedience did not give him license to disobey, even once. Our ability to live faithfully before the Lord is directly tied to our constantly *remembering* God's Word.










There are three things that have to be worked out in order for God to dwell amongst us:

- 3. Sin must be atoned for.


