


The End Does Not Justify the Means Rom. 3:8

And why not say, "Let us do evil that good may come"? --as we are slanderously reported and as some affirm that we say. Their condemnation is just.




Our Sins Will Always Find Us Out

The Wages of Sin Are Certain Heb. 2:1-3

1 Therefore we must give the more earnest heed to the things we have heard, lest we drift away.

2 For if the word spoken through angels proved steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just reward.

3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him.

Accountable For Our Own Actions

- 1. Upset, Anger No Excuse for Sin Num. 20:4
- 2. Bathsheba Influenced David, David Still Guilty 2 Sam. 11
- 3. Others followed Peter, All Guilty Gal. 2:11-14
- 4. False Leaders & Followers Both Fall Into Ditch Mt. 15:14
- 5. Adam blamed Eve, Eve the Serpent—Both Wrong (Gen. 3)
- 6. Amnon's Friend Aided Him in Sin (2 Sam. 13:2-5)
- 7. May be led by others into sin, but no one to blame but self!
 - Drinking, Drugs, Dancing, Immodesty, Gambling
 - Cursing, Cheating on Job, Forsaking Assembly
 - Rom. 12:1-2; 1 Cor. 15:33; 1 Pet. 4:3
