



LET'S LEARN FROM SOLOMON



Solomon's Temple




The SEVEN PILLARS of WISDOM


1st Pillar

The heart of the discerning acquires knowledge, for the ears of the wise seek it out.


3rd Pillar — Seeking good counsel or advice.



Prov. 11:14



4th Pillar — Foresight




