#### God Is Merciful! part 2

Matthew 5:38-42

Synopsis: Turn the other cheek. So well known, but so misunderstood. Jesus is teaching us not just to turn away from vengeance, but to choose to be merciful and kind to those who are evil. In this portion, we'll learn that mercy triumphs over judgment and that we are to overcome evil with good.
