

The Torn Curtain


To separate the Most Holy Place from the rest of the Temple sanctuary area

The curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom






Death of Jesus End of S O ration

The OT sacrificial system was merely a "shadow of the good things to come" (Heb. 10:1) ...




With the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross, our Passover Lamb "offered once, for all" (Heb. 7:26-28), the Substance had arrived.
