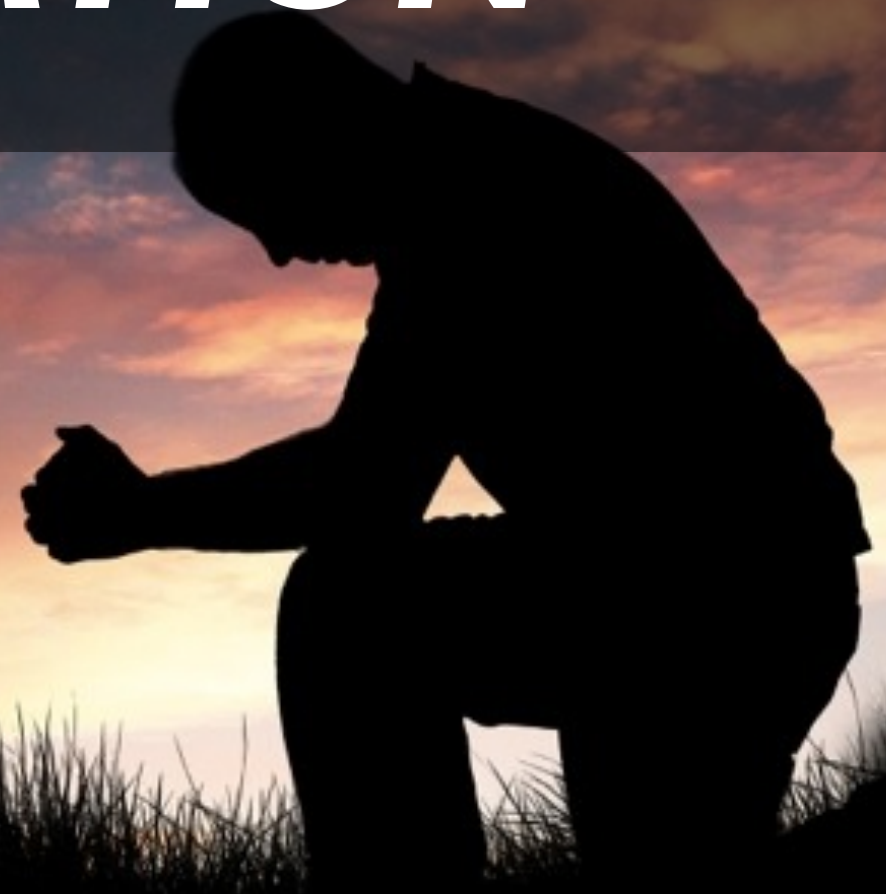

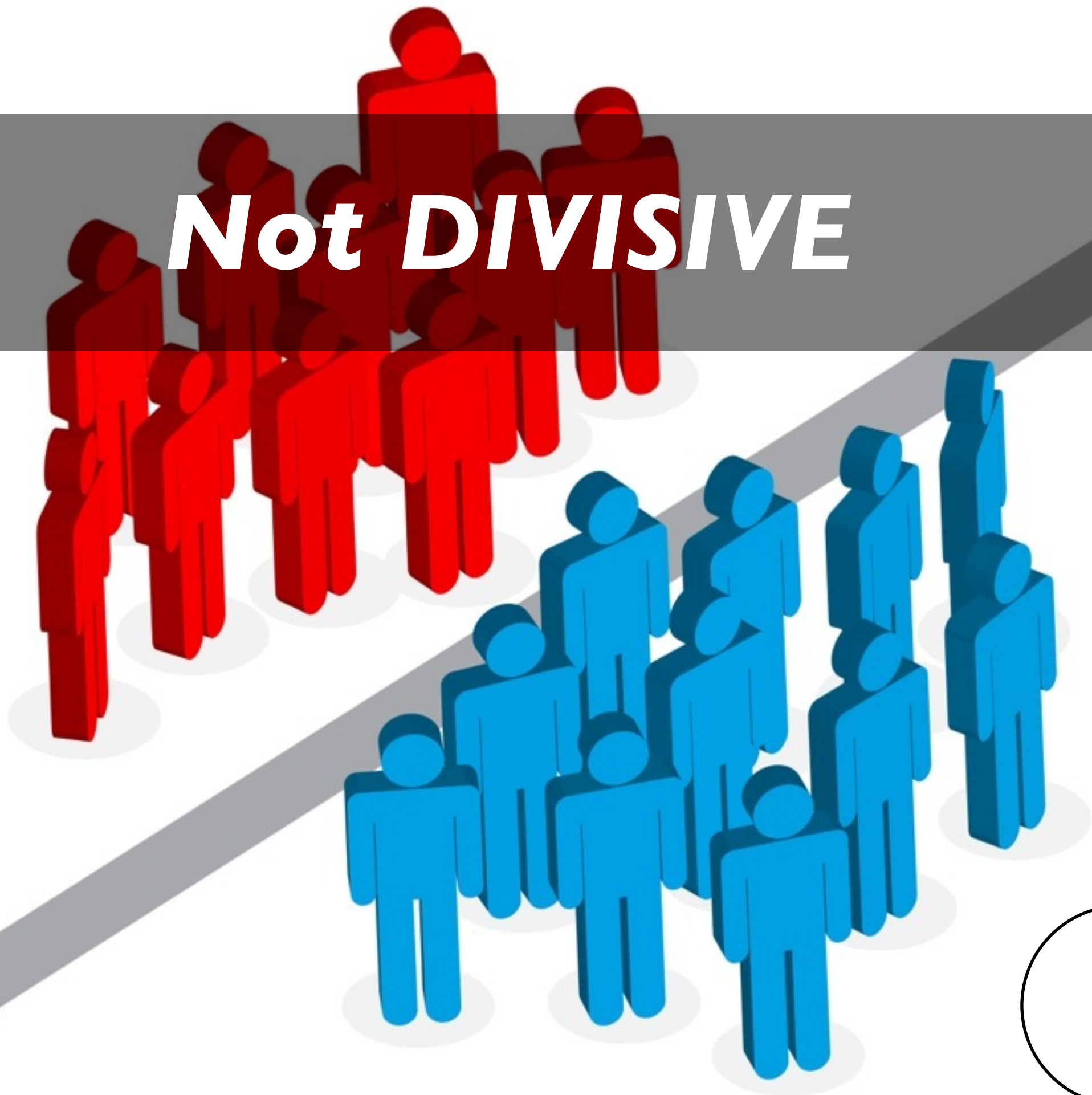

While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul traveled through the interior regions until he reached Ephesus, on the coast, where he found several believers. ² **“Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?” he asked them.** “No,” they replied, “we haven’t even heard that there is a Holy Spirit.” ³ “Then what baptism did you experience?” he asked. And they replied, “The baptism of John.” ⁴ Paul said, “John’s baptism called for repentance from sin. 1 Corinthians 14:2;4 NKJV

² For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands *him*; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.....**⁴ He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself,** but he who prophesies edifies the church.

Romans 8:26-27 NLT

¹⁴ For if I pray in tongues, my spirit is praying, but I don't understand what I am saying. ¹⁵ Well then, what shall I do? I will pray in the spirit, and I will also pray in words I understand. I will sing in the spirit, and I will also sing in words I understand. ¹⁶ For if you praise God only in the spirit, how can those who don't understand you praise God along with you? How can they join you in giving thanks when they don't understand what you are saying?

1 Corinthians 14:28 NLT

²⁷ No more than two or three should speak in tongues. They must speak one at a time, and someone must interpret what they say. ²⁸ But if no one is present who can interpret, **they must be silent in your church meeting and speak in tongues to God privately.**

Romans 8:28 NLT

²⁶ And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for.
