#### MEET AND MOVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

#### Acts 1:2-5 NLT

 $^{2}$  .....until the day he was taken up to heaven after giving his chosen apostles further instructions through the Holy Spirit. <sup>3</sup> During the forty days after his crucifixion, he appeared to the apostles from time to time, and he proved to them in many ways that he was actually alive. And he talked to them about the Kingdom of God.<sup>4</sup> Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, "Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. <sup>5</sup> John baptized with water, but in just a few days you will be **baptized** with the Holy Spirit."

# WHY be baptised in the Holy Spirit?

## Promised + Expected + Normal

### Joel 2:28-29 NKJV

<sup>28</sup> "And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions. <sup>29</sup> And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.

#### Matthew 3:11-12 TMSG

<sup>11-12</sup> "I'm baptizing you here in the river, turning your old life in for a kingdom life. The real action comes next: The main character in this drama-compared to him I'm a mere stagehand — will ignite the kingdom life within you, a fire within you, the Holy Spirit within you, changing you from the inside out. He's going to clean house — make a clean sweep of your lives. He'll place everything true in its proper place before God; everything false he'll put out with the trash to be burned."

#### Mark I:7-8 NLT

<sup>7</sup> John announced: "Someone is coming soon who is greater than I am — so much greater that I'm not even worthy to stoop down like a slave and untie the straps of his sandals. <sup>8</sup> I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit!"

## Not SALVATION




## HOLY SPIRIT

#### Acts 19:1-7

While Apollos was in Corinth, Paul traveled through the interior regions until he reached Ephesus, on the coast, where he found several believers.<sup>2</sup> "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" he asked them. "No," they replied, "we haven't even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." <sup>3</sup> "Then what baptism did you experience?" he asked. And they replied, "The baptism of John." <sup>4</sup> Paul said, "John's baptism called for repentance from sin. But John himself told the people to believe in the one who would come later, meaning Jesus." <sup>5</sup> As soon as they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. <sup>6</sup> Then when Paul laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they spoke in other tongues and **prophesied.** <sup>7</sup> There were about twelve men in all.


















tongues is >> a spirit language directed toward God for the purpose of edification often employed in weakness Interpretation = edification in community

## I Corinthians 14:2;4 NKJV

#### <sup>2</sup> For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God, for no one understands *him*; however, in the spirit he speaks mysteries.....<sup>4</sup> He who speaks in a tongue edifies himself, but he who prophesies edifies the church.

#### **Romans 8:26-27 NLT**

<sup>26</sup> And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. <sup>27</sup> And the Father who knows all hearts knows what the Spirit is saying, for the Spirit pleads for us believers in harmony with God's own will.

### I Corinthians 14:14-16 NLT

I will sing in the spirit, and I will also sing in words I understand. <sup>16</sup> For if you praise God only in the spirit, how can those who don't understand you praise God along with you? How can they join you in giving thanks when they don't understand what you are saying?

#### I Corinthians 14:28 NLT

<sup>27</sup> No more than two or three should speak in tongues. They must speak one at a time, and someone must interpret what they say. <sup>28</sup> But if no one is present who can interpret, **they must be silent in your church meeting and speak in tongues to God privately.** 

#### Romans 8:28 NLT

<sup>26</sup> And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for.
