

### WHAT IS PEACE?

- 1. <u>English</u>: freedom from disturbance; tranquility; the cessation of war; absence of war, conflict or trouble
- 2. Greek: εἰρήνη (eirene) = reconciliation
- 3. <u>Hebrew</u>: שָׁלוֹם (shalom)= prosperity

#### 1. A False Gospel

Jer. 6:14 "Peace, peace; when there is no

peace"

I Thess. 5:3 "For when they shall say, 'Peace and safety'; then sudden destruction cometh upon them."



#### 2. A Wicked Heart

Jer. 17:9 "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked...

Isa. 48:22 "There is no peace," says the LORD, "for the wicked."

רָשָׁע (rā·šāʿ) = to make tumult, to be disturbed

#### 2. A Wicked Heart

**Rom. 5:1** Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,

**2 Cor. 5:17–18** Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. <sup>18</sup> Now all things *are* of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation,

- **2 Pet. 3:14** Therefore, beloved . . . be diligent to be found by Him in peace


# WHAT PROMISE IS GIVEN TO A PEACEMAKER?

Where there is sadness, joy.




O Divine Master,
