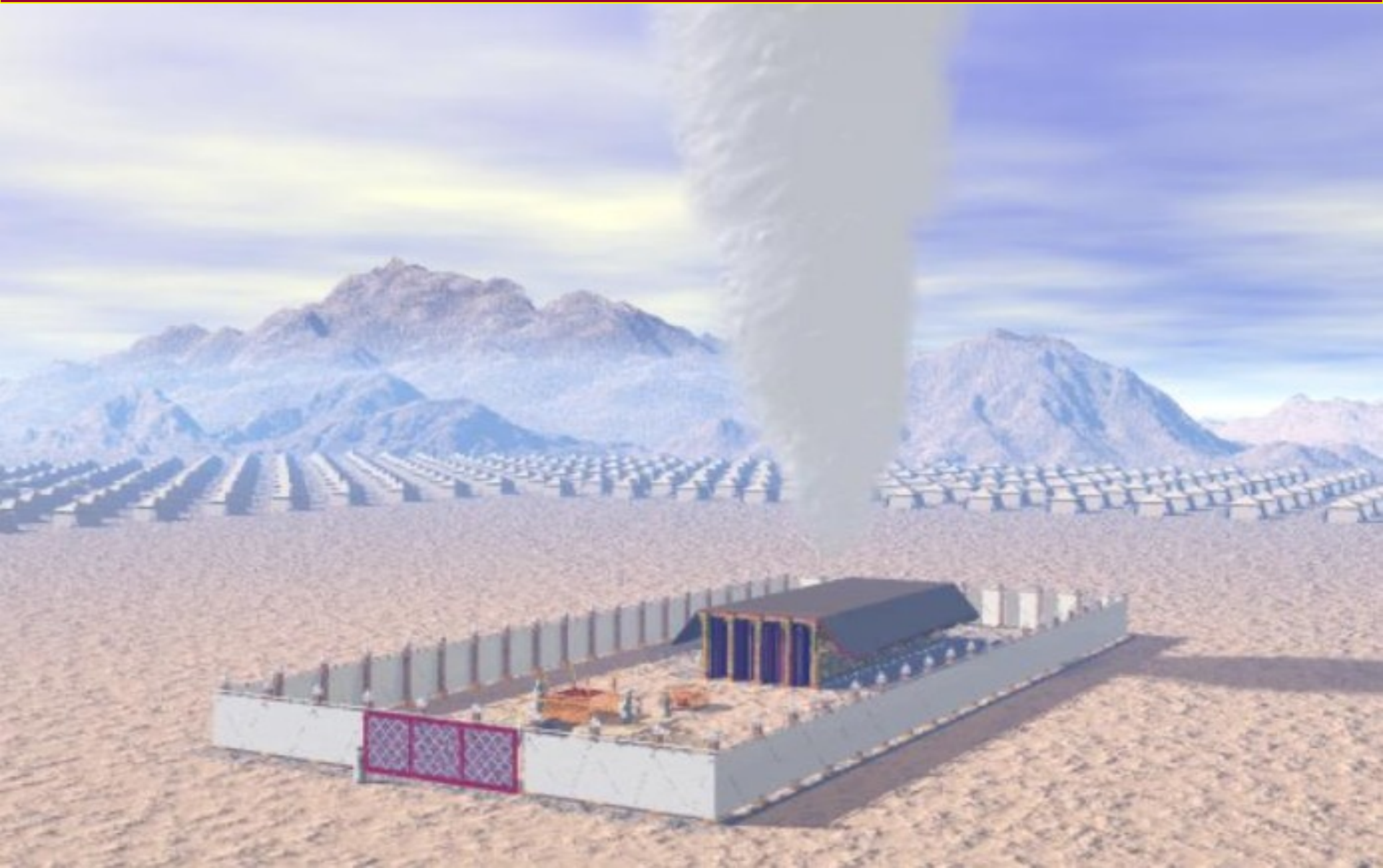

- A TYPE- IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

(TYPE- Divinely purposed illustration of some truth)

- SHADOW OF THINGS IN HEAVEN

(Heb.8: 2; 5; Heb. 9: 24; Rev.15: 5)

- NAMES CALLED

Tent of the congregation (Ex.39: 32)

Tent of meeting (Ex.29: 42)

The Tabernacle (Ex.26: 1)

Tabernacle of witness (Acts.7: 42)

The Sanctuary (Heb.8: 2)

(Ex.25-31; 35-40)

THE TENT OF MEETING WAS SHADOW

1. Of things in Heaven (Heb.8: 5; 9: 24)
2. Of Christ incarnated (Jn.1: 14; 1.Tim.3: 16)
3. Of the Church of God (Eph.2: 22; 1.Tim.3: 15)

• THE SOURCE OF MATERIALS

Willful offerings (Ex.25: 2-7; 35:4-29; 36:7; 38: 8)

• THE PURPOSE OF THE TABERNACLE

The Lord to dwell among his people (Ex.25: 8)

For the use in the wilderness (Acts.7: 44)

THE TABERNACLE

(Materials and Colours)

- **MATERIALS** – What it represented ?
- **SHITTIM WOOD** (Corruptible humanity)
- **GOLD** (Incorruptible deity)
- **SILVER** (Redemption)
- **BRASS** (Survived the judgment)

- **COLOURS-** (Shows four profiles of Christ)
- **PURPLE** (King- As in the gospel - **MATTHEW**)
- **WHITE LINEN** (Servant- (Righteous)- **MARK**)
- **SCARLET** (Human- Bled and died – **LUKE**)
- **BLUE** (Devine- As in gospel- **JOHN**)

THE TABERNACLE

(Israel – the chosen people)

- Exodus 19: 5-6 ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nations.
- Exodus 40: 38 The cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys
- Deut.4: 7 For what nation is there so great, who hath God so nigh unto them, as the LORD our God is in all things that we call upon him for?

(Now Church a peculiar people chosen in Christ – 1.Peter 2: 9)

THE TABERNACLE

PILLAR OF FIRE AND PILLAR OF CLOUD

- Exodus.40: 36-38 And when the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the children of Israel went onward in all their journeys: if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up. But day

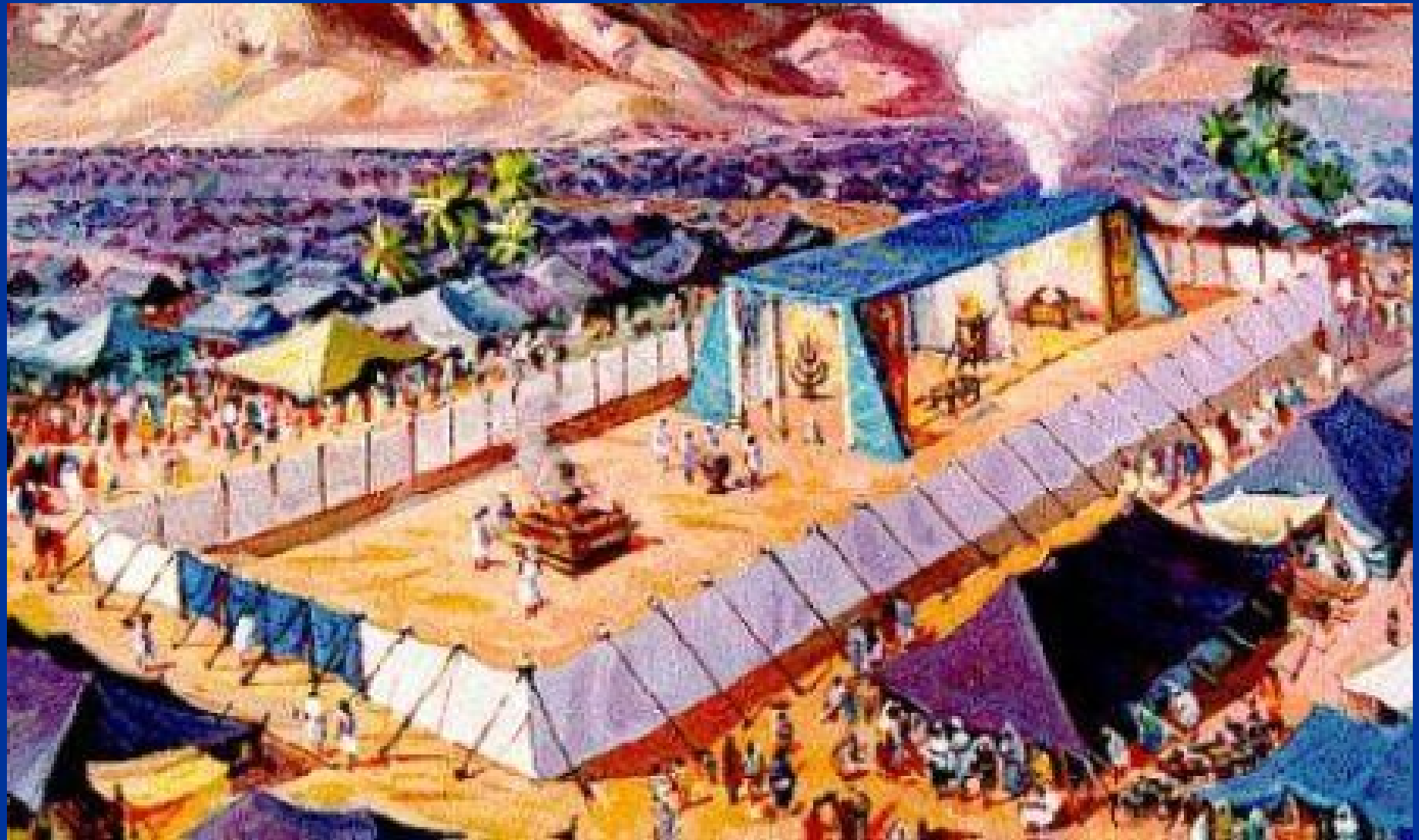
For the cloud of the LORD was upon the tabernacle by day, and fire was on it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel, throughout all their journeys.

- Numbers.9: 19 And when the cloud tarried long upon the tabernacle many days, then the children of Israel kept the charge of the LORD, and journeyed not. (V.15-23)

(All movements were on divine guidance only)

THE TABERNACLE

- **How amiable are thy tabernacles, O LORD (Ps.84: 1)**

(desired by every Israelite- Ps.122: 1)

- **Tent was at the center and they longed for it.**

(See picture - shows the general view of the camp)

- Heb. 9:1-4 Then verily the first covenant had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary.

For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the shew bread; which is called the sanctuary.

And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all; Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold.

- The mercy seat and the candlestick fully of Gold, and the Laver with brass

THE TABERNACLE

HOW LONG TABERNACLE WAS IN USE

- Acts 7: 44-45 Our fathers had the tabernacle of witness in the wilderness, as he had appointed, speaking unto Moses, that he should make it according to the fashion that he had seen.

Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drove out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David

(For a period of 350 years)

HOW IT WAS FOR A WORSHIPPER

- Psalms 84: 3-4 Yea, the sparrow hath found an house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, even thine altars, O LORD of hosts, my King, and my God.

- **SHADOW OF CHRIST**

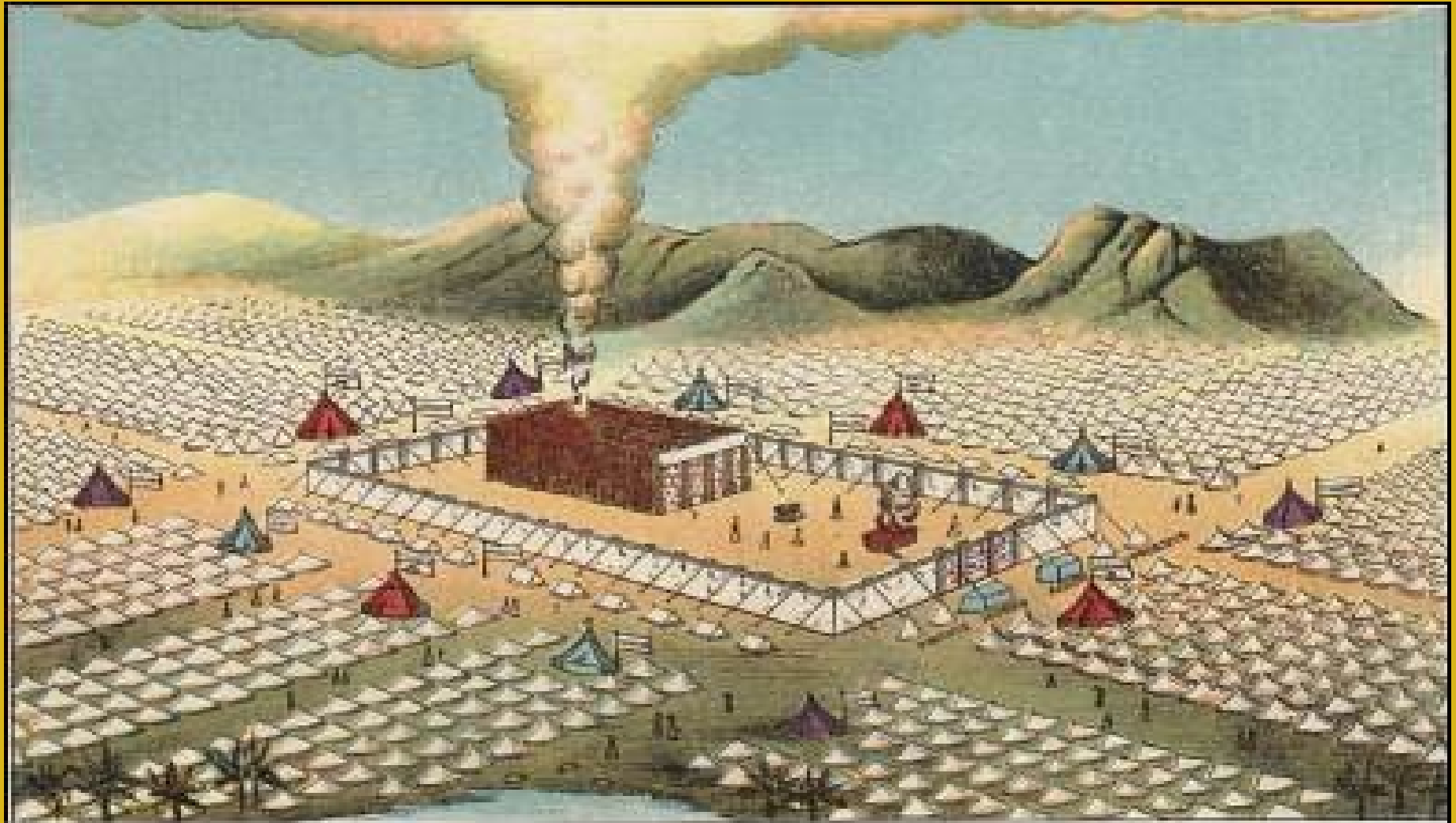
Luke 10: 22 No man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him.

THE TABERNACLE

- **ARRANGEMENT OF CAMPING** (Num. Ch.2)

(Judah- v.3; Reuben v.10; Ephraim 18; Dan v.25)

The tabernacle was at the center (v. 17)

- Colossians 1: 18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

The divine order in the camping (v.34)

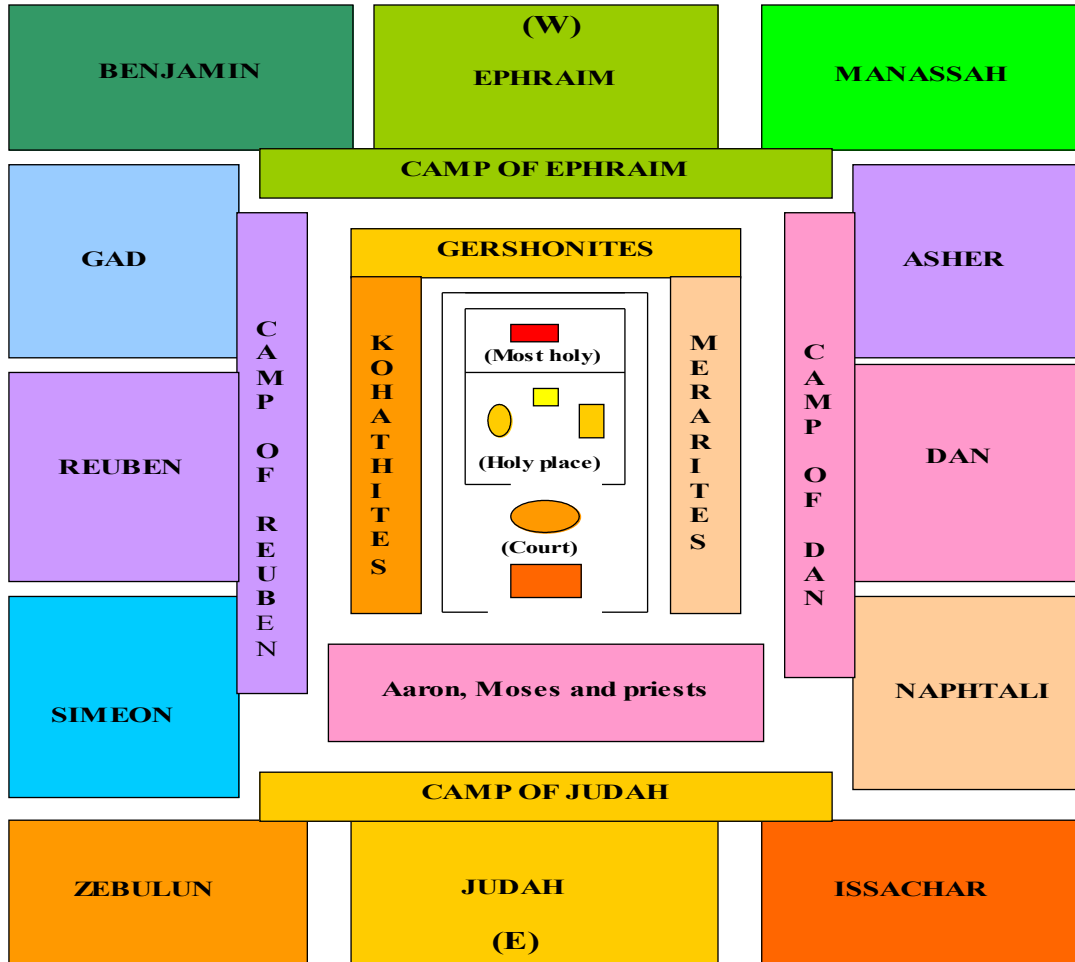
- 1 Cor.12: 27-28 Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular. And God hath set some in the church, first apostles, secondarily prophets, thirdly teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of healings, helps, governments, diversities of tongues.

Tabernacle was at the centre (Num.2:2)

- **Camp of Judah East**
(Num.2: 3)
- **Camp of Dan North**
(2: 25)
- **Camp of Reuben South**
(2: 10)
- **Camp of Ephraim West**
(2: 18)

Every tribe as allotted in their places only allowed to camp)

God is not the God of confusion. This truth we could see in the arrangements of the camp of Israel. He has set also the order in the church. God hath set some in the Church, first the apostles, secondarily the prophets, thirdly the teachers, after that miracles, then healings, help, governments (1.Cor. 12: 28) That thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave in the church of the living God (1. Tim. 3: 15)

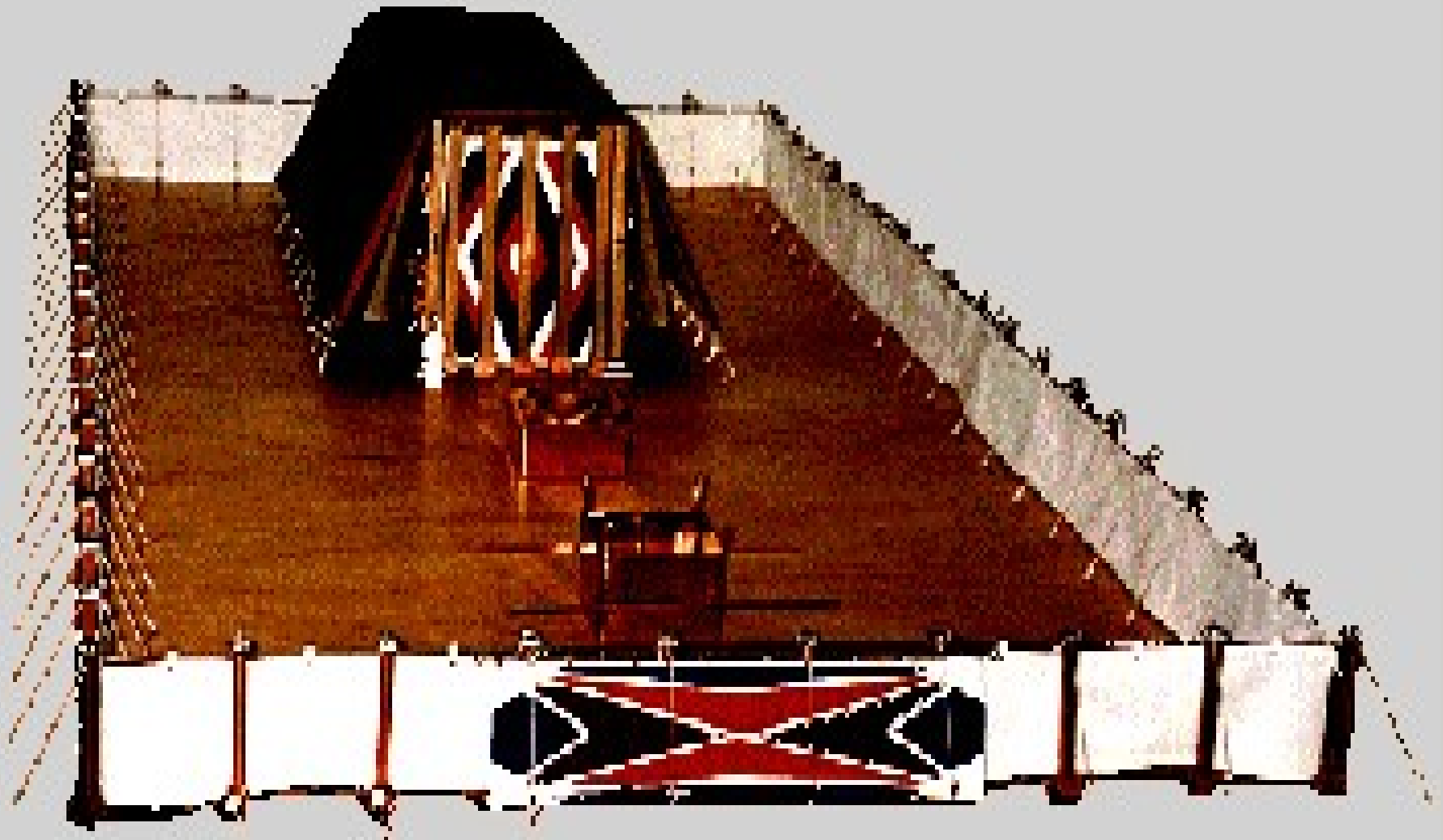
COVERINGS OF THE TABERNACLE

- **Had four coverings (Ex.26: 1-14; 36: 8-19; 40: 19)**
 1. Curtain made of twined linen, blue, purple, and scarlet (Ex.26: 1-6)
Four colours the four profiles
 2. Curtains of goat hair (Ex.26: 7- 13)
 3. Covering of Rams skin dyed red (Ex.26: 14)
 4. Covering above of badger's skin (Ex. 26: 14)

(Stranger looked from far had nothing of attraction- Is.53: 2; Mk.6: 3)

THE TABERNACLE

The court of the tabernacle



THE TABERNACLE

- **THE COURT – (Of the Tabernacle)**

(Ex.27: 9-19; 38: 9-20; 40: 33)

- Length 100 cubit, Breadth 50 cubit height 5 cubit (v.18)
Hangings separated worshiper from world
- South 20, North 20, West 10 and East 10 Pillars each
- Pillars all on sockets of brass, with fillets of silver
- One Gate (v.16) width 20 cubits, hanging made of Blue, purple, scarlet and fine linen

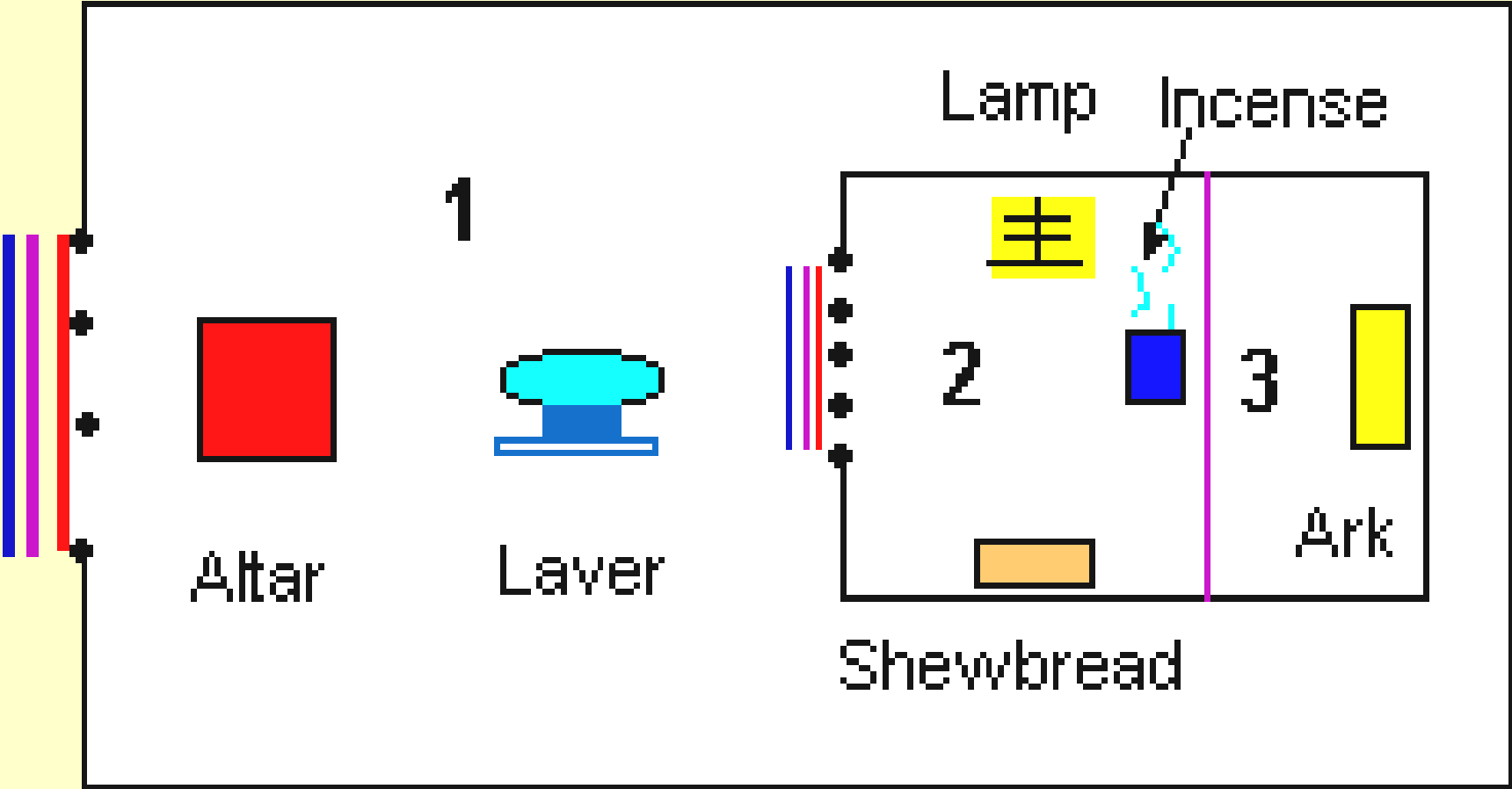
(Shows profiles of Christ- the only door -Jn.10: 7; 14: 6)

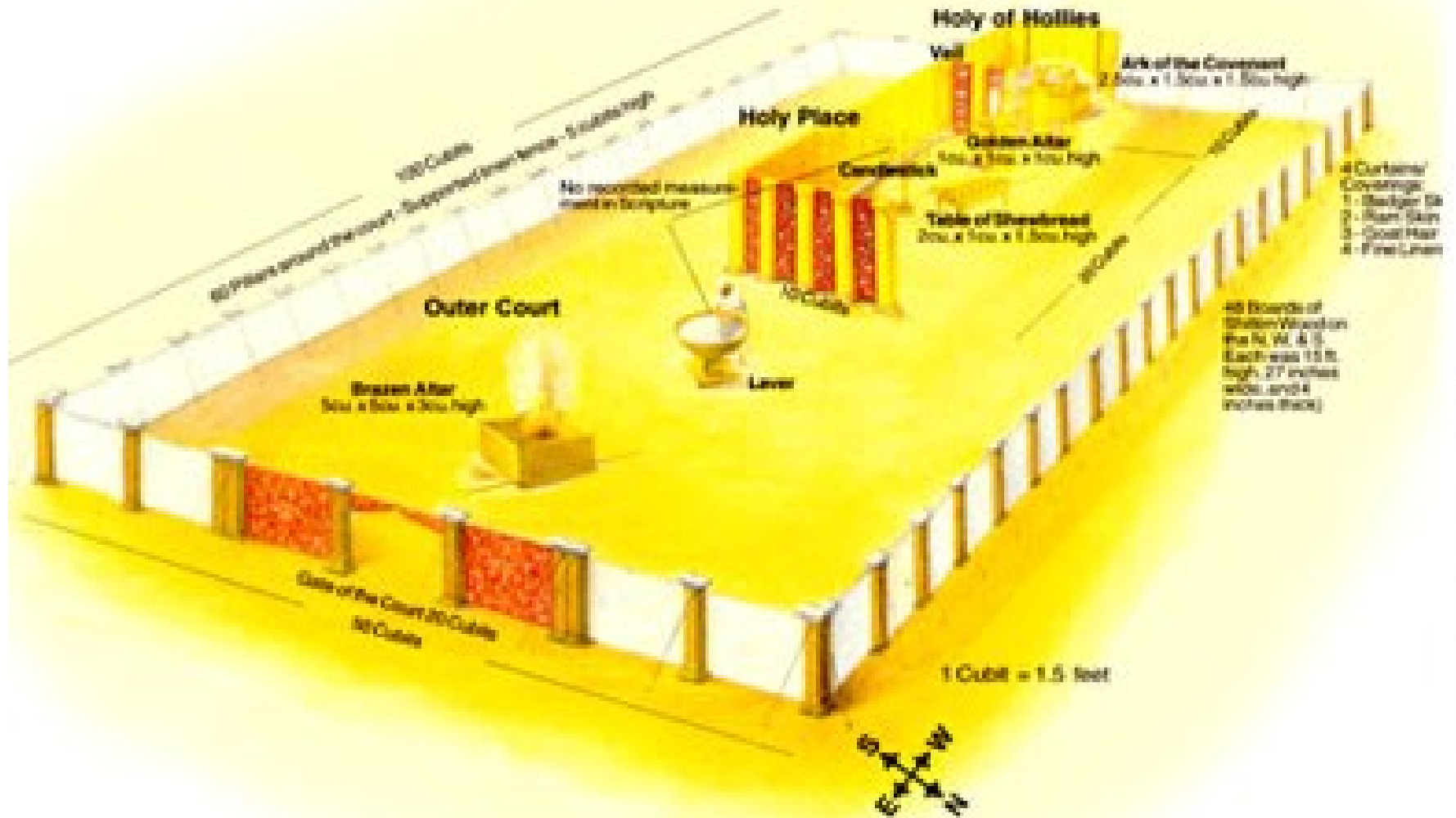
(Entering to the tabernacle)

- **ONE DOOR- Christ the only way (Jn.14: 6)**
 - a. For Salvation (Acts.4: 12)
 - b. For worship (Eph.2: 18)

- **INSTRUMENTS IN THE COURT (Ps.84: 2)**
 - 1. Alter of burnt offerings (Ps.84: 3)
 - 2. The laver (Jn.17: 17)

- Hebrews. 9: 14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Outline structure of the Tabernacle

THE TABERNACLE

(Ex.40: 20- 33)

INSTRUMENTS IN THE TABERNACLE

- **ALTER** (L 5 x b 5 x h 3 Cubits) Ex.27: 1-8
- **LAVER** (Measure not given-Brass) Ex.30: 17-21
- **LAMP** (One talent of gold) Ex.25: 31-40
- **TABLE** (L 2 x b 1 x h 1 ½ Cubits) Ex.25: 23-30
- **ALTER OF INCENSE** (L 1x b 1x h 2) Ex.30: 1-10
- **ARK** (L 2 ½ x b 1 ½ x h 1 ½ Cubit) Ex.25: 10-17
- **MERCY SEAT** (L 2 ½ x b 1 ½ Cubit) Ex.25: 17-22

(Mercy seat was lid of the ark -made of pure gold with Cherubim of beaten work as covering)

TABERNACLE

(Shittim wood was chosen)



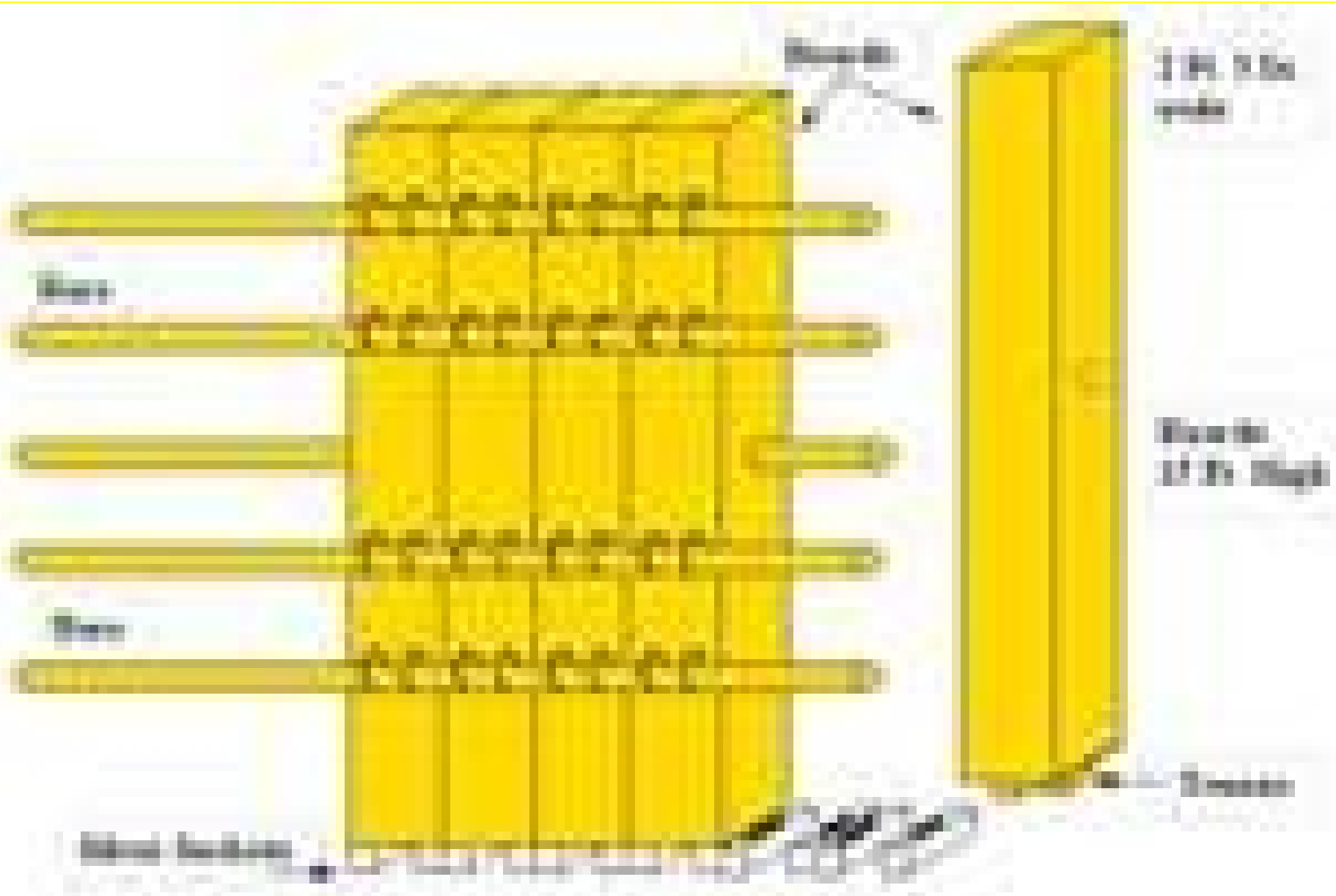
Shittim wood (Accacia)

- Grows in the desert
- Thorny in nature
- Always tossed by wind
- Hard to get of required size
- Rough and unfinished
- Wood dark in colour
- Not good for furniture

(Usually grows in the desert; destined to fall down in the wind, decay or burn off by wild fire.)

TABERNACLE

(Boards, rings, bars and base- Ex.26: 15-30; 36: 20-34; 40: 28)



THE TABERNACLE

SANCTUARY- (Length 30, Width 10, Height 10 Cubits)

- With boards of Shittim wood covered with Gold, standing up (Ex.26: 15)
- Holy and Most Holy Separated by Veil (Ex.26: 33)
- All boards standing on silver sockets (Ex.26: 19)
- Five bars passed thru all boards (V.27; Eph.4: 11)
- Middle bar reached end to end (v.28; Acts.2: 42)

(No boards without gold inlaid, nor without bars pass thru; and with out standing on silver sockets

(Boards the shadow of believers and character required)

THE TABERNACLE

THE TABERNACLE

- **PRIEST ENTERED DAILY TO THE HOLY PLACE**
(Morning and evening daily offerings- Ex.30: 7-8)
- **FIRST COURT; THEN THE HOLY PLACE**
All ministries in the light of the lamp. (Num.8: 3)
Shown incense daily at the golden alter.(Ex.30:8)
- **VEIL FORBID ENTRY TO THE MOST HOLY PLACE**

Heb. 9: 11-12 But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building;

Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.

TABERNACLE

- Alter with grate of brass

THE TABERNACLE

(Alter of burnt offerings- Ex.27: 1-8; 38: 1-7; 40: 29)

1. ALTER OF BURNT OFFERINGS

- Made of Shittim wood, overlaid with brass (V.1) L 5 x B 5 x H 3 cubits
- With four horns on it (V.2; Ps.118:27; Ex.21:14)
- All accessories of brass only (V. 3)
- Grate of brass placed inside (V. 4-5)
- Made with rings and stakes to carry (V. 6)
- Fire shall never go out (Lev.6: 13)
- Must not use strange fire (Lev.10: 1)
- No leaven to burn on it (Lev.2: 12)
- Source of brass for construction (Num.16: 40)

THE TABERNACLE

1. Priest ministering at the alter



THE TABERNACLE

- **UNIQUENESS OF CHRIST –As high priest**
- Heb.10: 11-12 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, **sat down on the right hand of God; (Heb.1: 3)**
- Heb.10: 14 For by one offering **he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.**
- Heb.10: 18 Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.

THE TABERNACLE

- Priest washing hands and legs at the laver

THE TABERNACLE

(The Laver - EX.30: 17-20; 38: 8; 40: 30)

2. THE LAVER

Made of brass only (Measurement not given)

- Put water within (Ex.30: 18)
- For washing hands and feet (V. 19-21)

(Feet shows walk; And hands the work; need the cleansing - Jn.13: 10)

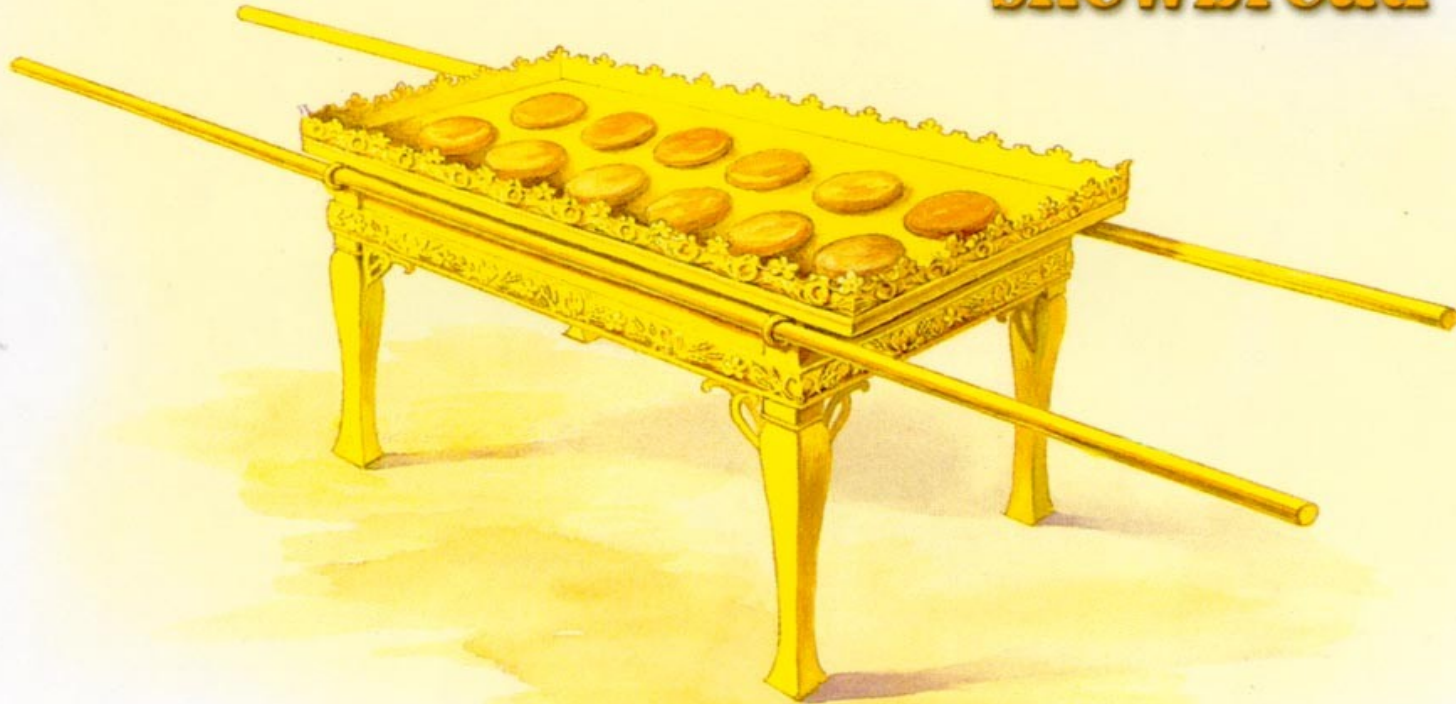
- Shows the unlimited cleansing power of the word (Jn.17: 17)
- Washed before entered to holy place (v. 20)
- **Source of Brass (Ex.38: 8)**

THE TABERNACLE

(Table of shewbread- EX.37: 10-16; 37: 10-16; 40: 22)

- **Table and the shewbread in two rows**

THE TABERNACLE

(Table of shewbread- EX.37: 10-16; 37: 10-16; 40: 22)

3. THE TABLE OF SHEWBREAD

- **MADE OF WOOD OVERLAID WITH GOLD (V.10-12)**
- With crowns, and rings to carry
- Length 2; breadth 1; and height 1 ½ cubits (V.10)
- All accessories of gold only (V.16)
- **Use of the Table** –To keep the Shewbread
- Preparation of Shewbread (Lev.24: 5-9)
- Bread the food for the Priests (V.9)
- **Lesson for us (Jn.12: 24; Eph.5: 2; Jn.6: 21- 58)**

THE TABERNACLE

(Table of shewbread- EX.37: 10-16; 37: 10-16; 40: 22)

- Arrangement - a different view in column



THE TABERNACLE

(Shewbread-Lev.24: 5-9; 40: 23)

- **ARRANGEMENT OF BREAD** (The two different views can be seen in the differences in pictures)
- **TWO ROWS; SIX ON A ROW (V.6)**
- **Christ the bread of life for us.** (The priest only ate it; we are the priesthood of him; must feed on him.)
- **Changed on Sabbath,** shows the need of dedication (Rom.12: 1; Lk.6: 3-4; 1.Sam.21: 4)
- **As fruit of the ministries of 12 Apostles,** we to have an open life of dedication before the Lord

4. THE CANDLESTICK (The Lamp) Num.8: 1-4

- **SHADOW OF CHRIST THE LIGHT (Jn.8: 12)**
- **But more it types the "WORD OF GOD"**
(A comparative study highly be appreciated)
- Lamp and accessories all of Gold (1 Talent)
- Made a s whole as beaten work (V. 36)
- With branches, knobs and flowers (v. 34)
- The lamp must burn always (Ex.27: 20)
- **OLIVE OIL (Pure beaten) USED (Ex.27: 20)**

THE TABERNACLE

(The altar of incense)

THE TABERNACLE

(Alter of Incense- Ex.30: 1-10;37: 25; 40: 26)

5. THE GOLDEN ALTER (Ex.30: 1-12)

- Made of wood inlaid with gold (V. 3) (L 1 x B 1 x H 2 cubits)
- To burn the daily incense (V. 1; 7-9)
- With horns (V.2) to apply the blood (V.10)
For atonement (Lev.16: 18)
- With rings and staves to carry (V. 5)
- Shadow of Christ; Now glorified; Makes intercession for us (1.Tim.2: 5-6)
- Preparation of incense (Lev.30: 34-38)

THE TABERNACLE

Priest inside the Holy place (Daily entered two times)



THE TABERNACLE

(THE HOLY PLACE- Ex.40:3-5; 22-28)

INSTRUMENTS IN THE HOLY PLACE

- **THE CANDLESTICK** – (South) **To provide light**
- All ministries in the light of it **(Ex.30: 7-8)**
- **THE TABLE OF SHEW BREAD** (North) **Ex.40: 22)**
- To place new bread on Sabbaths **(Ex.40: 23)**
- **ALTER OF INCENSE** – (Front) **To burn Incense;**
And to apply blood on the horns of it. **(Ex.40: 26)**

(THE VEIL SEPARATED FROM THE MOST HOLY PLACE)

THE TABERNACLE

(Veil - Ex.26: 31-33; 36: 35-36; 40: 21)

- Hebrews. 9: 6-7 The priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without blood, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people:
- Heb.9: 12 Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.
- Heb.9: 24 For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:
- Hebrews 10: 19-20 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

THE TABERNACLE

(Ark-Ex.25:10-16; 37:1-5; 40: 20)

- The ark of the covenant

The Ark and
the Mercy-Seat



THE TABERNACLE

(Ark-Ex.25:10-16; 37:1-5; 40: 20)

6. THE ARK OF THE COVENANT

- Made of wood overlaid with gold. (V.10-11) L 2 ½ x B 1 ½ x H 1 ½
- With rings and staves to carry (V.13-15)
- **SHADOW OF CHRIST (Humanity & Deity)**
- Heb. 9: 4 Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;
- **Only instrument taken to the temple of Solomon**
(2.Chro.5: 4-10; 1. King.8: 9)

(When temple was destroyed; History says Jeremiah hid it)
- **None will search for it (Jer.3: 16)**

TABERNACLE

- **Blood sprinkled over the mercy seat**



THE TABERNACLE

(Mercy seat-Ex.25: 17-22; 37: 6-9; 40: 20)

7. THE MERCY SEAT

- **Of pure gold only- (Cover over the Ark-Ex.25: 21)**
- **Shadow of Christ (Mercy is purely divine-Eph.2: 4)**
- **“Covering” As covered things placed in the ark.**
- **“Propitiation” As blood sprinkled on (Lev.16:14-16)**
- **With cherubim looking down (v.20)**
- **Calls us to receive grace (Heb.4: 16)**
- **Ex.25: 22** And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the testimony.

TABERNACLE

God who desires to dwell among his people

- **Mt.Sinai- the law (Ex.19: 18-19) x Desire to make a tent(Ex.25:8)**
- **Spake.. from tabernacle (Lev.1:1) x Dwelt among us.. (Jn.1: 14)**
- **From midst of cherubim-Ex.25:22 x Word become flesh.. (Jn.1: 14)**

Exodus 25:8 And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them.

2 Cor 6:16 God hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their God, and they shall be my people. (Lev 26: 12)

The church - God's Dwelling place on earth now

- **Eph 2:22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.**
- **House of God, which is the church of the living God (1.Tim.3: 15)**

TABERNACLE

He dwells in us (In every believer)

- 1 Corinthians 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the **Spirit of God dwelleth** in you?
- John 14:23 Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and **we will come unto him, and make our abode** with him.
- Colossians 1:27 To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ in you**, the hope of glory:
- Romans 8:11 But if **the Spirit of him** that raised up Jesus from the dead **dwell in you**, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his **Spirit that dwelleth** in you.

(Now He lives in us and we in him- 1.Jn.3: 24)

TABERNACLE

The TENT compared to the TEMPLE

Tent always a temporary structure (Ex.25: 9)

Building a permanent structure (1.King 6: 1)

The Tent of meeting

Fixed to earth only by pins connected with rope (Job.4: 21)

First was the Tabernacle in the wilderness (Acts.7: 44)

All structures stood on base of Brass or silver (Ex.26: 19)

Jesus Christ he dwelt (tabernacled) among us (Jn.1: 14)

The Temple of God

First temple built by Solomon in Jerusalem (1.King 6: 1-7)

The Temple with foundation (1. King 5:17; Ch.6; Lk.21: 5)

Now believers in the body on the earthly tent (2.Pet.1. 13)

Soon will put on the building the heavenly one. (2.Cor.5: 1)

TABERNACLE

- **My soul fainteth for the Courts of the Lord;**
- **THE COURT (Of the Tabernacle) Ex.26:9-19**
(Was rectangular- Length 100; breadth 50; height 5 cubits)
- The hanging of the court was of fine linen
- The hangings separated from the camp around
- Pillars made of wood, standing on sockets of brass
- Pillars had fillets on top and hooks of silver
- Hanging on the gate was of four colours
 - Any one had to enter thru the front gate
 - Which was the meeting place (tent of meeting)
 - The wide gate was welcoming him
 - Could come with an offering
 - Right inside was the alter of burnt offering

(An Israelite could come up to the court only)

TABERNACLE

THE SANCTUARY (Ex.Ch. 26)

Had four coverings

- **1. Curtain of FINE LINEN (Sanctuary with cherubim)**

Ten pieces: Each 28 cubit length and 4 cubits width

Each had five loops on one side - to join with other)

Five each coupled together (with golden taches- v.6)

(Was seen from inside and not visible out side- Ps.84:1)

Seen by God and all who serve within the sanctuary)

- **2. Curtain of GOAT HAIR (covering the sanctuary- v.12)**

Eleven pieces: Each 30 cubit length and 4 cubit width

five together and six together coupled with brass taches

(Seen to the back and front and overlapped-v. 12-13)

Where is the lamb? (Gen.22: 8) Seen only when drawn near

- **3. RAM'S SKIN DYED RED (size not given-v.14) Covered**

Redemption work (Thru the sacrifices) but not seen out side

TABERNACLE

- **4. The BADGER'S SKIN *(Outer covering)* Not known what?**

Looked from far- Nothing demanded attraction (**Is.53:2-3**)

Place: Nazareth – (**Jn.1: 45-46**; The land of Cabul- **1.Ki.9: 13**)

Origin: Is not this the carpenters son (**Mat.13: 55**)

Birth: Kept in manger (since no place in the Inn. **Luke.2: 7**)

Childhood: lived at Nazareth (**Luke.2: 51**)

Early life: Despised by own country men- (**Mark.6:3-5**)

Occupation: Carpenter (**Mk.6: 3**)

His ministries: Friend of sinners and publicans (**Mat.11: 19**)

Death: Counted with transgressors (**Is.53: 12; Mat.27: 38**)

John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

- **No man knoweth the Son, but the father. (Mat.11: 27)**

TABERNACLE

We have an Alter; whereof(Heb.13:10)

THE COURT (Of the Tabernacle)

- **The gate (Only one door to enter- Jn.10: 1-10)**

John 10:9 I am the door: by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved.
(No other name given for salvation: Acts.4: 12)

- **The Alter (Largest of all instruments) fire always burning**

Alter build by Elijah on Mt.Carmel (1. King,18: 31)

- **The Old testament Theophanies of the Lord (Gen.14: 18-20)**
- **Revelation of the priesthood of Melchizedek (Ps.110: 4)**
- **Lord Jesus Christ, high priest after the order of Melchizedek.**
And in him we (believers) are the royal priests. (1. Pet.2: 9)

The gate and the door (court and sanctuary)

The gate of the court (Ex.27:16-18)

- **Length 20, height 5 cubit (v.16) A wide door**
 - Hangings with twined linen of four colours...(v. 16)
 - Four Pillars shittim wood on sockets (of Brass) v.18
 - Filleted with silver and hooks of silver (v.17)
 - All pins of brass (v.19) All vessels of brass (v.19)

The door of the sanctuary (Ex.26: 36-37)

- **Length 10, height 10 cubits (v.16) full width and height**
 - Hangings with twined linen of four colours (v. 36)
 - Five pillars overlaid with gold on socket (of brass) v.37
 - Hooks all of gold only (v.37)
 - All pins of brass (Ex.27:19) all vessels of gold (25:29;39)

(The gate of the court was wider compared to the door)

TABERNACLE

Let us draw near by faith... (Heb.10: 22)

- **To receive grace at the right time.**

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.

(Heb 4:15 For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities)

- **To render our spiritual worship**

Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

(Heb.10:21 And having an high priest over the house of God)

(Christ our high priest entered there before us)

TABERNACLE

Washed with the pure water.... (Heb.10: 22)

- **Laver (Pass the alter reaches the Laver) Ex.30: 17-21**
(Laver and its foots were of brass- but no measure given)
- **Use of Laver: to wash hands and feet before any service.**
- **No measure: Shows the unlimited cleansing power**
- **Made of: Polished brass given by woman (Ex. 38: 8)**

(No ministries allowed without washing at the Laver)

- **What the pure water means (The Spirit- Eze.36: 25)**

Hebrews 10:22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

(Shadow –consecration of Aaron and sons (Lev.8: 6; 30)

TABERNACLE

By a new and living way (Heb. 10: 20)

- Boards are of the same size (L- 10 x B- 1 ½ Cubit) v.16
- Each Boards stood upon 2 silver sockets (v.21)
- Each boards with 2 Tenons on it (v. 19)
- Boards had golden rings for the bars to pass (v.29)
- Bars made of wood overlaid with Gold (v.26-29)
- The middle bar passed thru end to end (v.28)
- All boards were set in one against the other (v.16)
- All boards must be standing up (v.15)

Eph. 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; (The bar that reaches end to end – Apostle's teaching)

TABERNACLE

The Believers the keepers of the truth

- **The hangings separated the court from the camp (Ex.26:9-19)**
- **The boards separated sanctuary from the court (Ex.28:15-30)**

The boards kept the instruments in the tabernacle

The lamp to burn without turned off (Ex.40: 24)

The bread on the table from the dust (Ex.40: 22-23)

The show of incense with out ceasing (Ex.40: 26)

The keepers of truth are the only true believers

Stands upon the redemption work (Silver base- Rom.5: 5)

Edified by the Spiritual ministry (Bars passed- Eph.4:11)

Not tossed by the winds of doctrine (Stands up- Eph.4: 14)

- **From the pollution of the world, Theft, Violators
(False worship, False doctrines, False imaginations)**

TABERNACLE

Thus were the journeys of ... (Num. 10 : 28)

- **Brief history of Journey. (Num Ch. 33)**
 - Started journey from Rameses. Date begun (Num.33: 3)
 - First place they pitched the tent at Succoth (Num.33: 5)
 - Last pitching of tent in the plains of Moab (Num.33: 48)
 - Within forty years journey 41 times pitched (Num. 33)
- Exodus 40:36-37 And when the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle, the children of Israel went onward in all their journeys: But if the cloud were not taken up, then they journeyed not till the day that it was taken up.
- **Must Journey with tabernacle in the midst (Num.2: 17)**
- First from the wilderness of Sinai (Num.10: 11-13 /Acts.14:23)
- The use of trumpets of silver (Num.10: 1-8)
- Order of Journey (Num. 10: 14; 18; 22; 25 / Heb. 13: 17)
- **Words of Assurance- of God's presence (Num.10:34-36)**

TABERNACLE

He bare them and carried them.. (Is.63: 9)

(Command-Ex. 25: 10-22; Place to keep- Ex.26: 33; Heb.9: 3-4)

- Commanded first among all instruments to build- (Ex.25: 10)
- Material used: Of Shittim wood; inlaid with Gold (Ex.25:10-11)
- **Things placed inside: (Heb.9: 3-4)**
 - The tablets of Law (Ex.40: 20)
 - The Aaron's rod (Num.17: 10)
 - The golden jar with Manna (Ex.16: 34)
- **The names called:**
 - The Ark (Ex.25: 10)
 - The Ark of the covenant of the Lord (1.Sam.4: 3)
 - The Ark of the Lord God (1.King.2: 26)
 - Holy Ark (2 Chro.35: 3)
 - The Ark of his Strength of the Lord (Ps.132: 8)
 - Strength of his glory (Ps.78: 61)

Staves like boards made of wood inlaid with Gold or Brass

Staves were representing the believers now carry Him.

When the labour is done will be removed (But not thrown out)

Precious in the sight of the death of his saints (Ps.116:15)

They were kept there, but not seen outside. (Mat.22: 32)
