LET'S REMEMBER THIS:

THE BIBLE DOESN'T SAY ANYTHING ABOUT WHAT GOD WAS DOING BEFORE HE CREATED EVERYTHING THAT IS AND EXISTS.

- But we know something about God's intentions.
- God had in His mind the creation of:
 - each spirit being,
 - the universe,
 - and each human being.
- God allowed rebellion and sin to come in, as a result of the use of <u>free will given</u> to his created beings.
- God determined mankind would be redeemed and glorified with Him forever.
- God made a pleasing way to Him for dealing with the rebellion and sin of man: The second Person of the Godhead (the Son of God) would become a man and die for our sins.
- God gives eternal life to those who believe that Messiah Jesus is their Redeemer.

GOD'S FIRST CREATION

- The bible mention that the first creation of God was in the spiritual realm:
- The creation of spiritual beings, the angels.
- When God the Father decided at some point in eternity, God the Son created the spiritual realm, He created the angels.

ANGEL DEFINITION

- Others, fallen angels, disobeyed, fell from their holy position, and now stand in active opposition to the work and plan of God.

PSALM 148:1-5 (NKJV)

PRAISE THE LORD FROM CREATION

- 148 Praise the LORD!
- Praise the LORD from the heavens;
 Praise Him in the heights!
 ² Praise Him, all His angels;
 Praise Him, all His hosts!
 ³ Praise Him, sun and moon;
 Praise Him, all you stars of light!
 ⁴ Praise Him, you heavens of heavens,
 And you waters above the heavens!

JESUS IS AT TIMES MENTIONED AS THE ANGEL OF THE LORD

- In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word for "angel" is malak, also meaning 'messenger'.
- The prophet Malachi took his name from this word. He was himself a messenger, and he prophesied about the coming of "the messenger of the covenant", Jesus Christ
- (Malachi 3:1).

MALACHI 3:1 (NKJV)

- The Coming Messenger
- 3 "Behold, I send My messenger, And he will prepare the way before Me. And the Lord, whom you seek, Will suddenly come to His temple, Even the Messenger of the covenant, In whom you delight. Behold, He is coming," Says the LORD of hosts.

REVELATION 1:20 REVELATION 2:1 (NKJV)

20 The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden lampstands: The seven stars are the angels of the seven and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.





2 KINGS 4: (NKJV) ELISHA AND THE WIDOW'S OIL

- 4 A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets cried out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the LORD. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves."
- ² So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil."
- Points on consideration: Presentation to the Seer. Who she is. Elisha's response

2 KINGS 4:8-10 (NKJV) ELISHA RAISES THE SHUNAMMITE'S SON

- 8 Now it happened one day that Elisha went to Shunem, where there was a notable woman, and she persuaded him to eat some food. So it was, as often as he passed by, he would turn in there to eat some food. And she said to her husband, "Look now, I know that this is a holy man of God, who passes by us regularly. Please, let us make a small upper room on the wall; and let us put a bed for him there, and a table and a chair and a lampstand; so it will be, whenever he comes to us, he can turn in there."
- Points of consideration: Elisha Invited to break bread with them.
- Who is invited to stay and who invites?
- What the furniture points to?

2 KINGS 4:29-31 (NKJV)

- ²⁹ Then he said to Gehazi, "Get yourself ready, and take my staff in your hand, and be on your way. If you meet anyone, do not greet him; and if anyone greets you, do not answer him; but lay my staff on the face of the child."
- ³⁰ And the mother of the child said, "As the LORD lives, and as your soul lives, I will not leave you." So he arose and followed her. ³¹ Now Gehazi went on ahead of them, and laid the staff on the face of the child; but there was neither voice nor hearing. Therefore he went back to meet him, and told him, saying, "The child has not awakened."
- Points of consideration: Gehazi is a servant commanded by his master to carry a mandate.

Why Gehazi didn't succeed?
