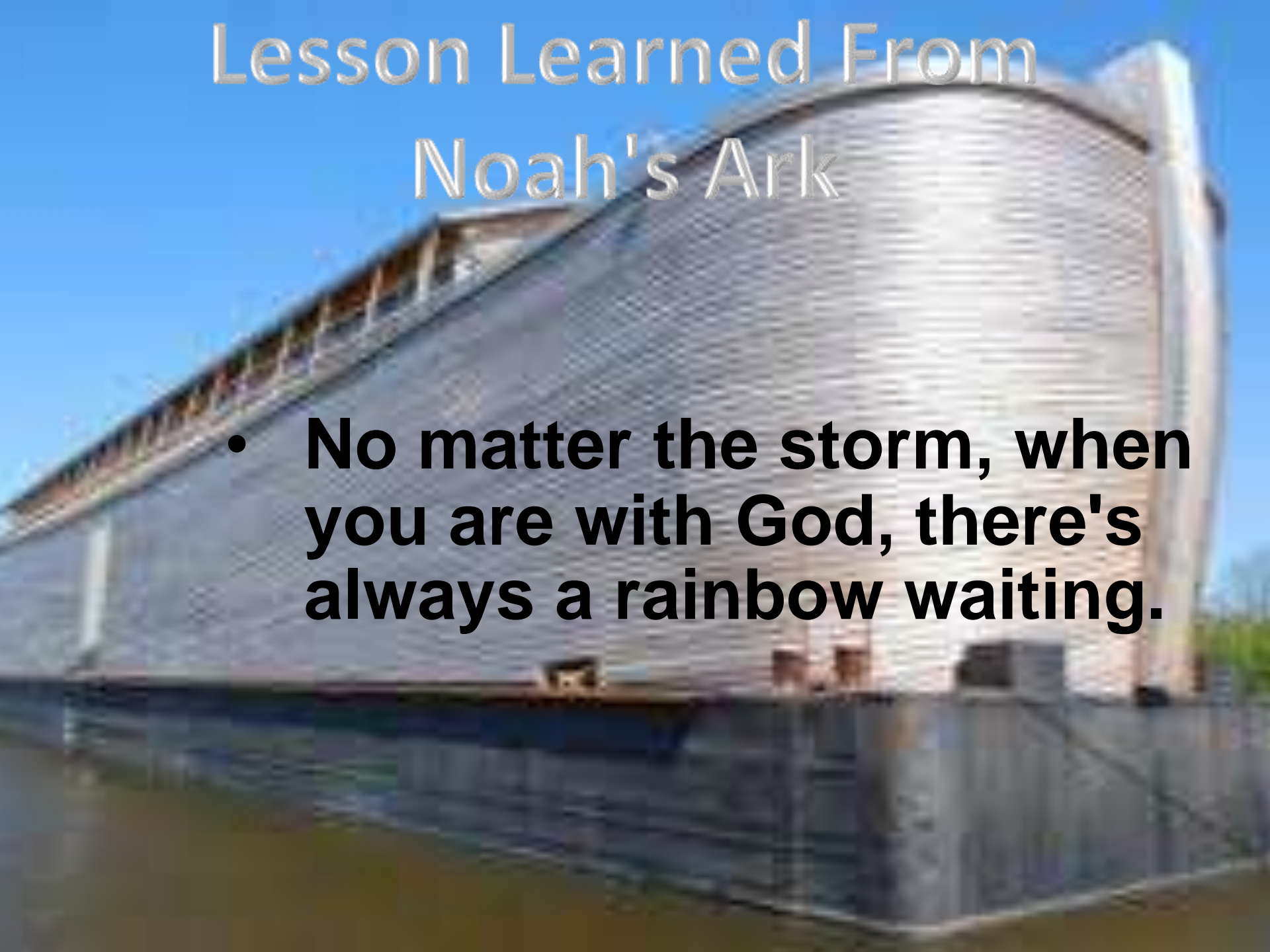

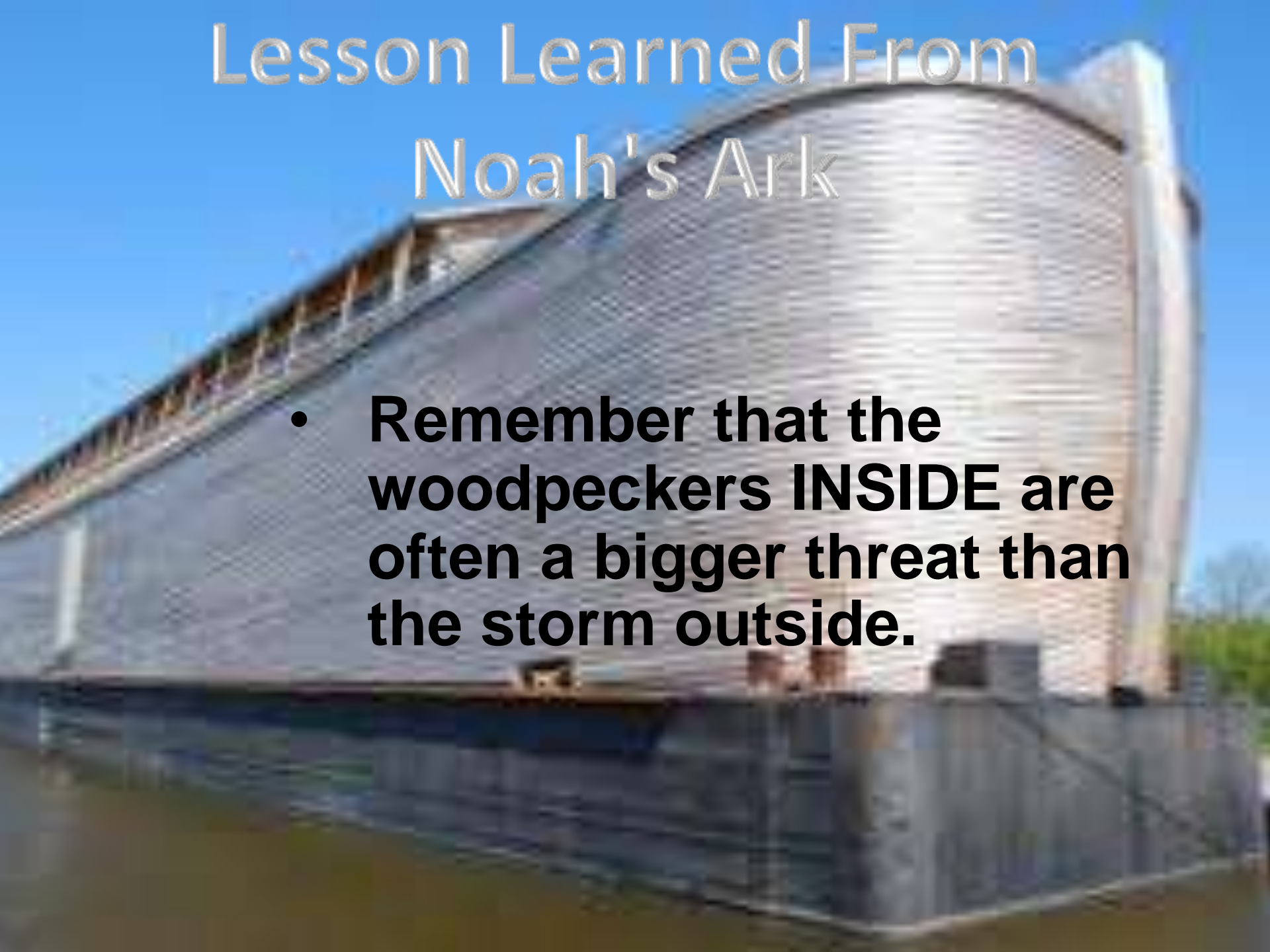
Lesson Learned From Noah's Ark

- **No matter the storm, when you are with God, there's always a rainbow waiting.**



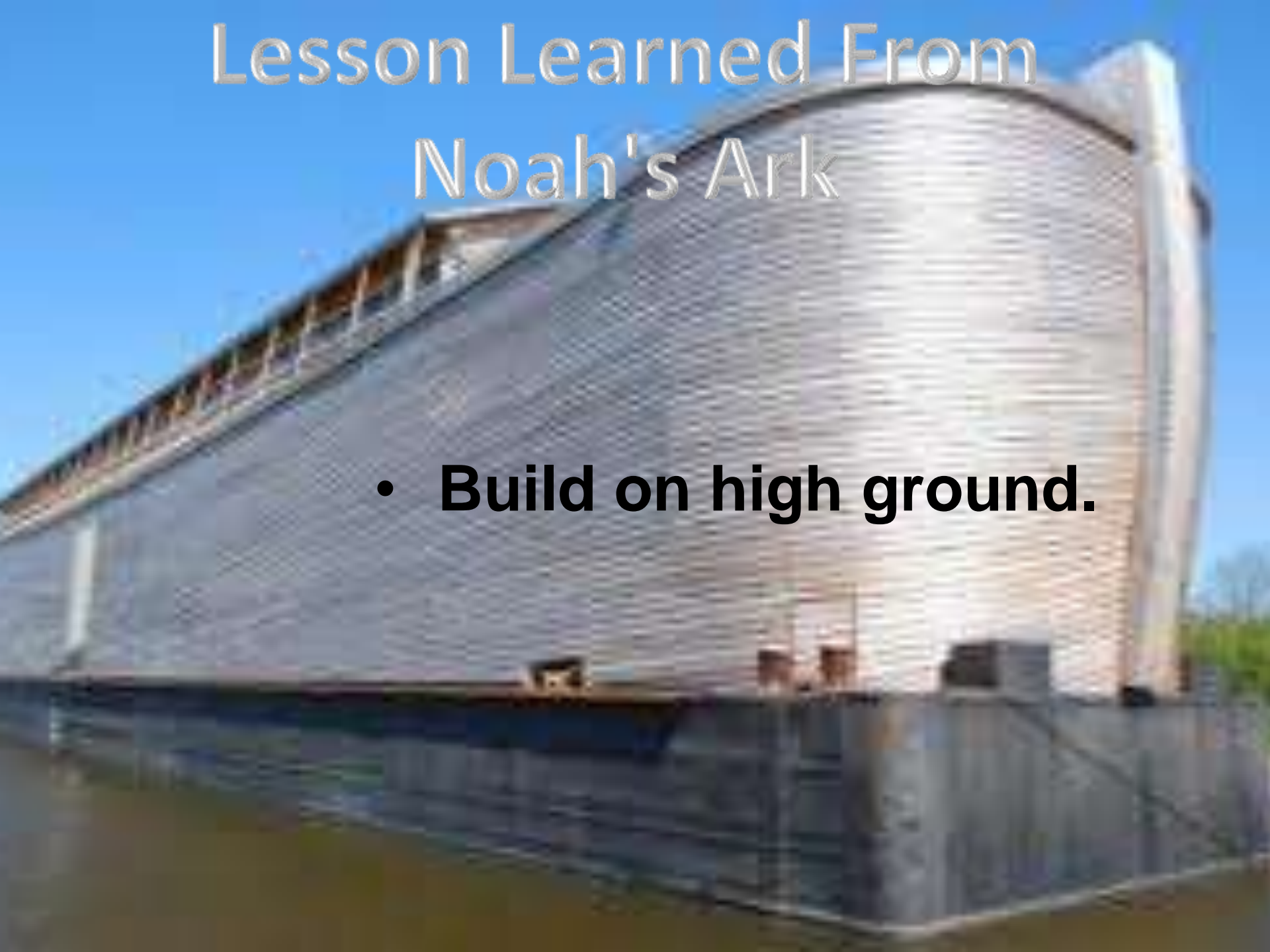
Lesson Learned From Noah's Ark

- **Remember that the woodpeckers **INSIDE** are often a bigger threat than the storm outside.**



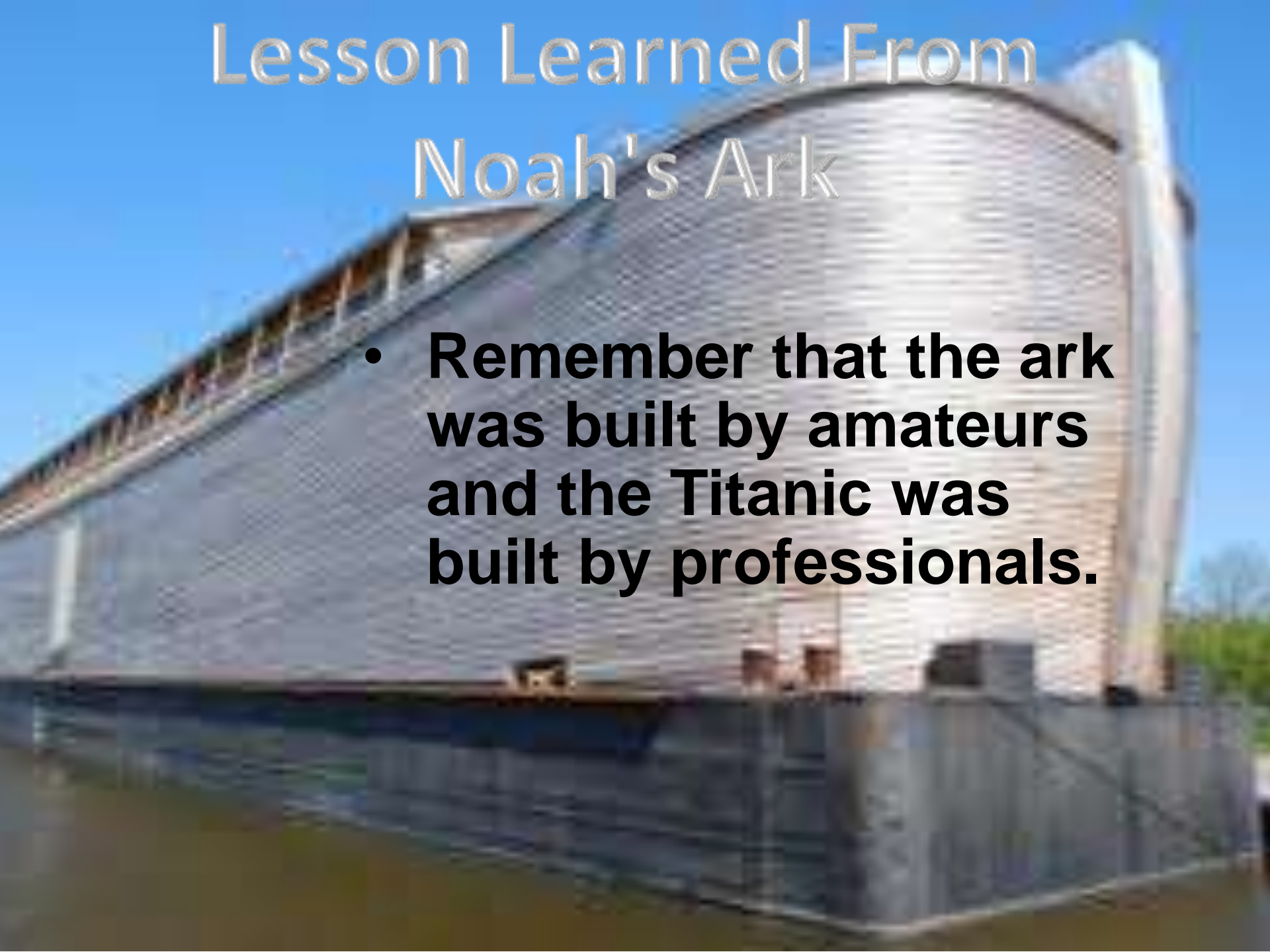
Lesson Learned From Noah's Ark

- **Build on high ground.**



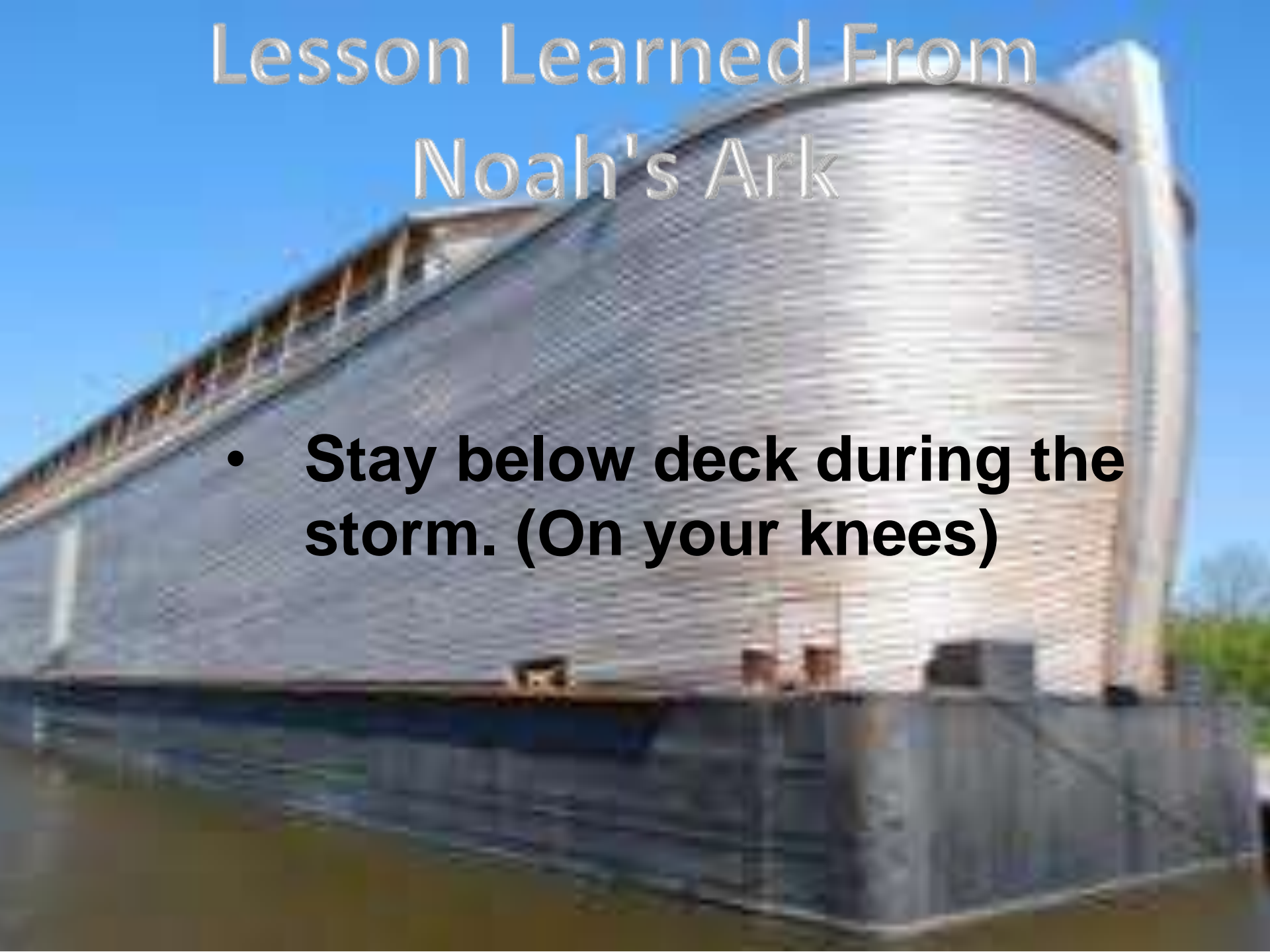
Lesson Learned From Noah's Ark

- **Remember that the ark was built by amateurs and the Titanic was built by professionals.**



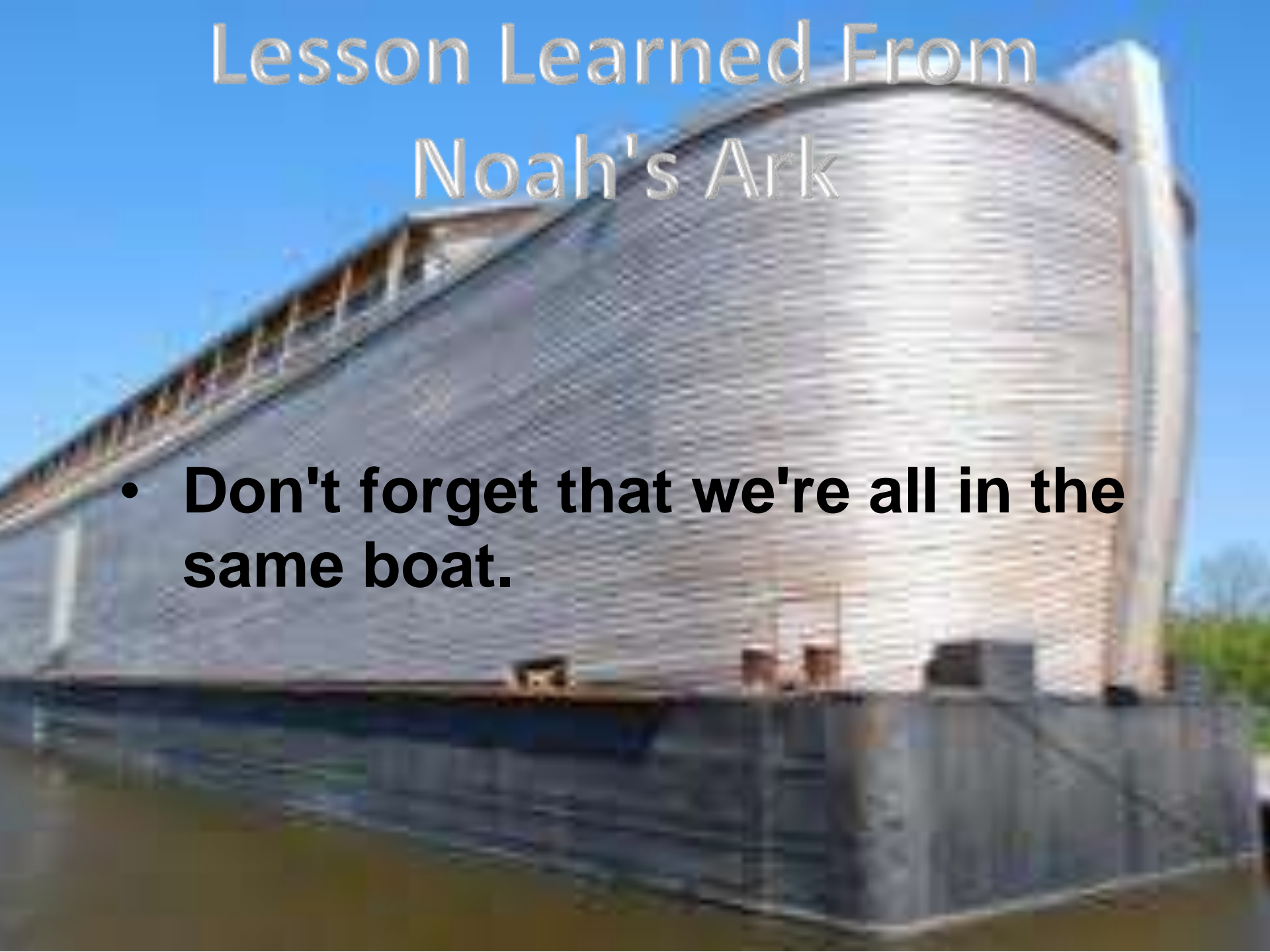
Lesson Learned From Noah's Ark

- **Stay below deck during the storm. (On your knees)**



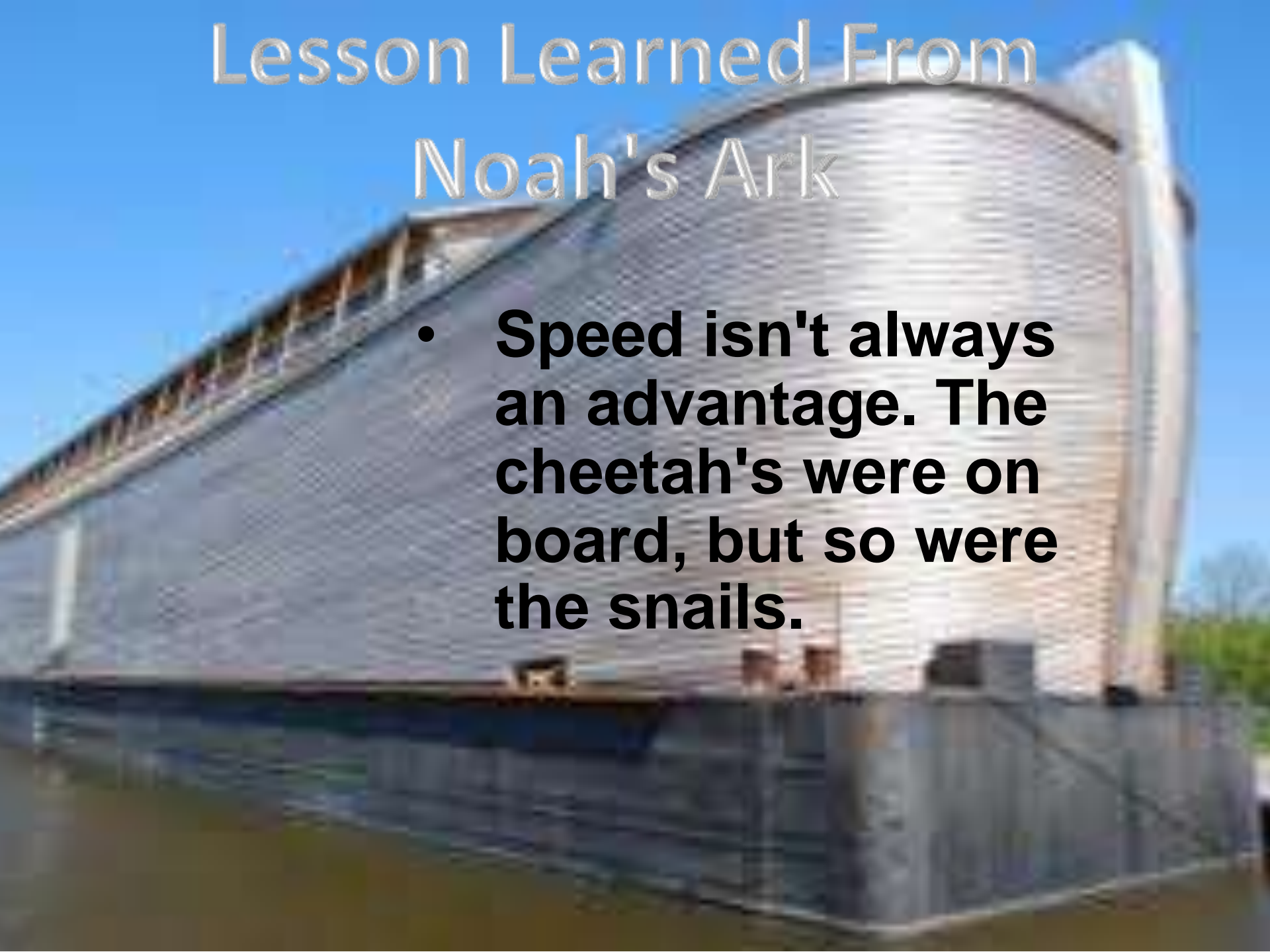

- **Don't forget that we're all in the same boat.**



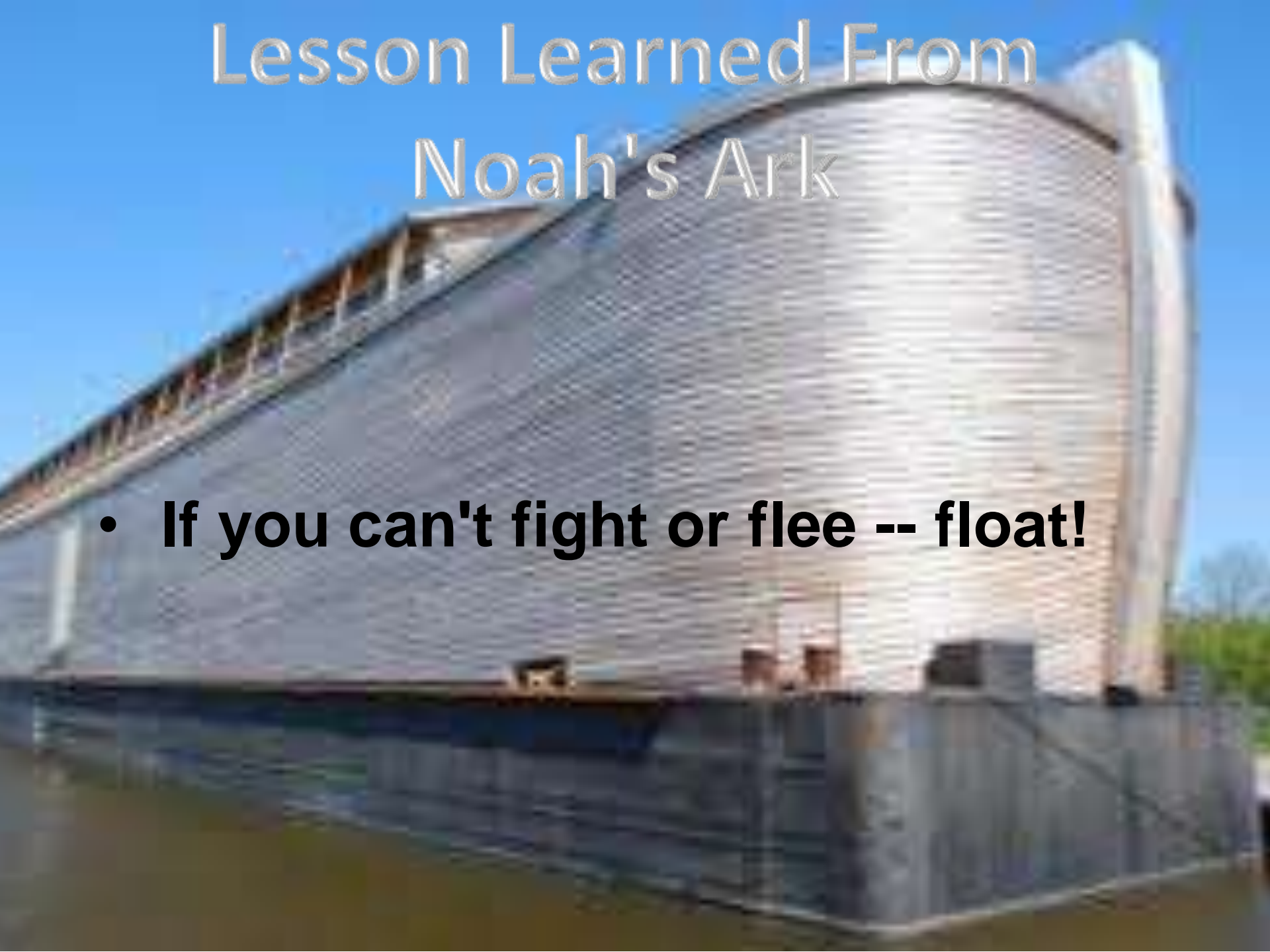

- **If you can't fight or flee -- float!**



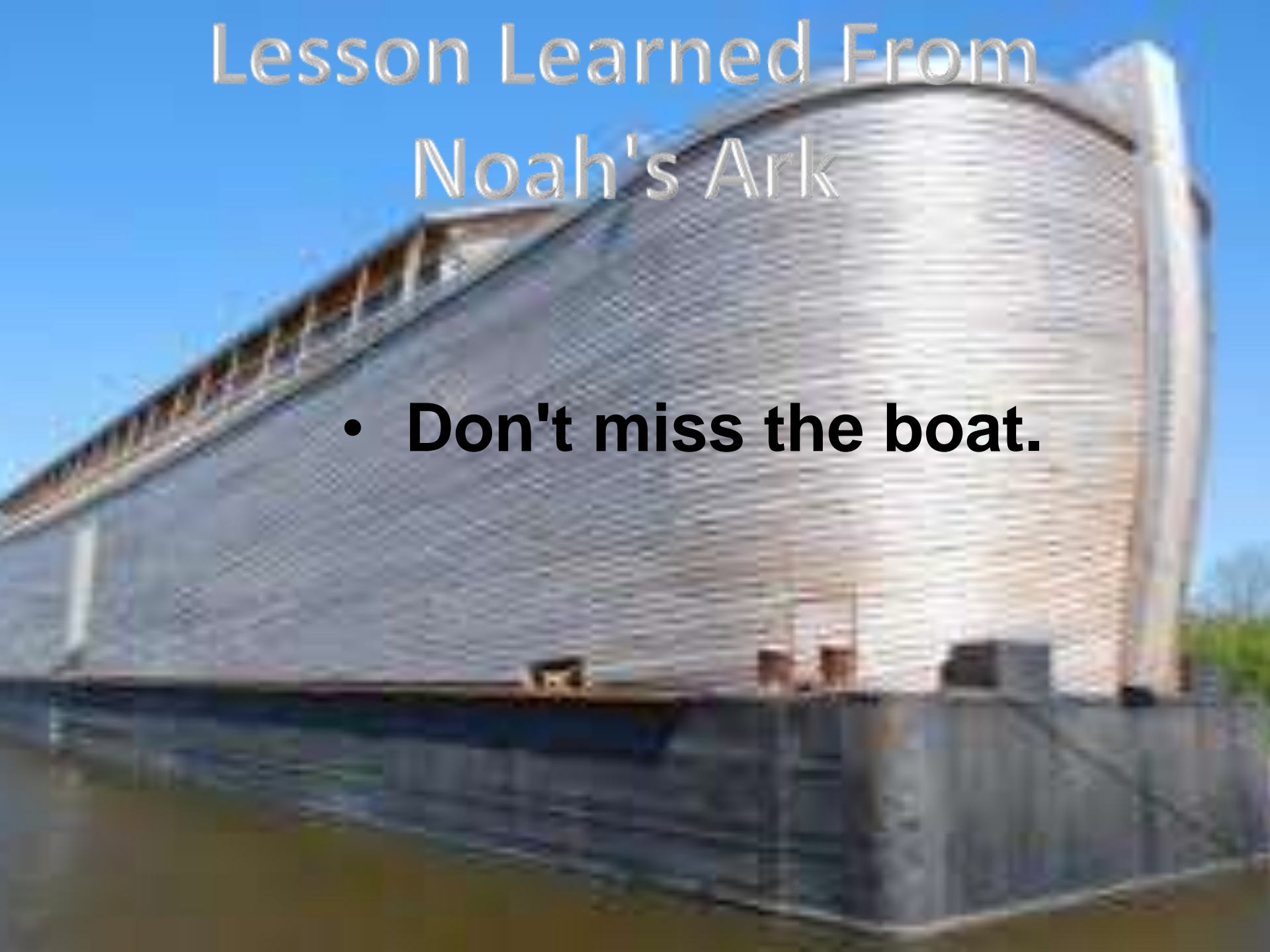

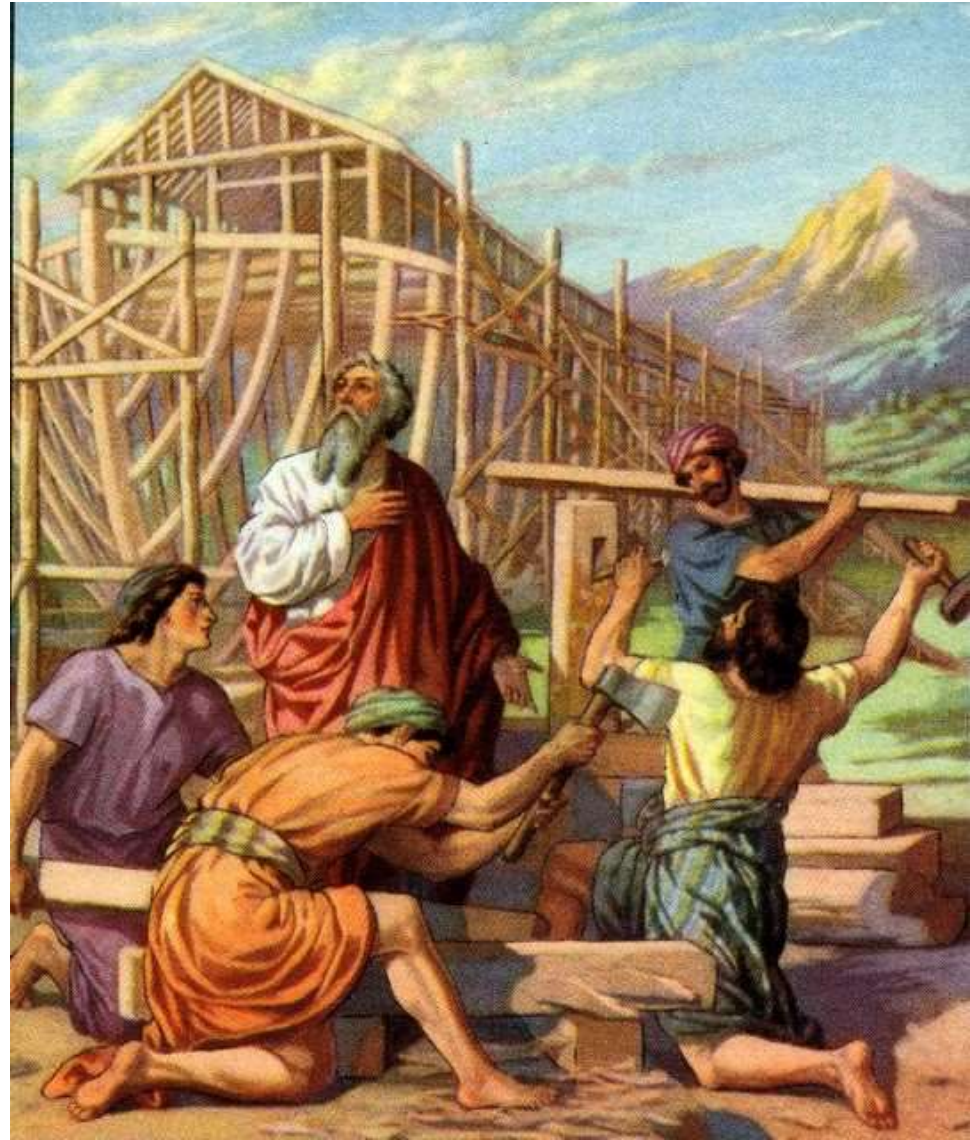

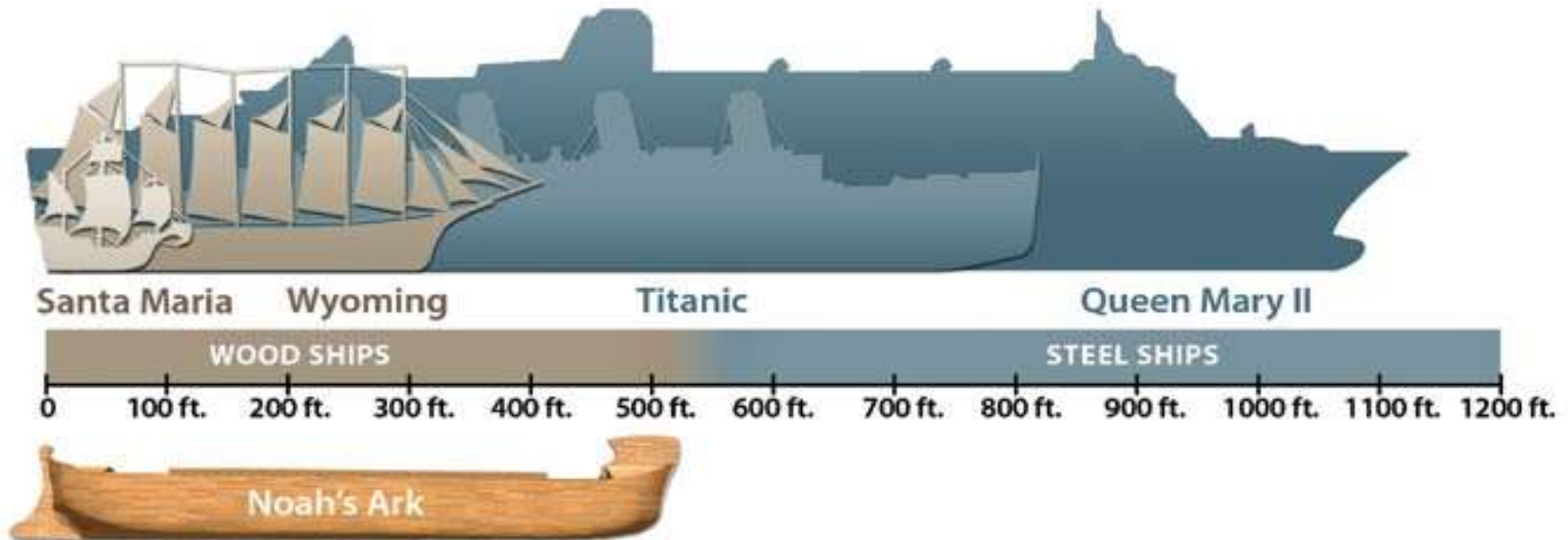

Size of Noah's Ark

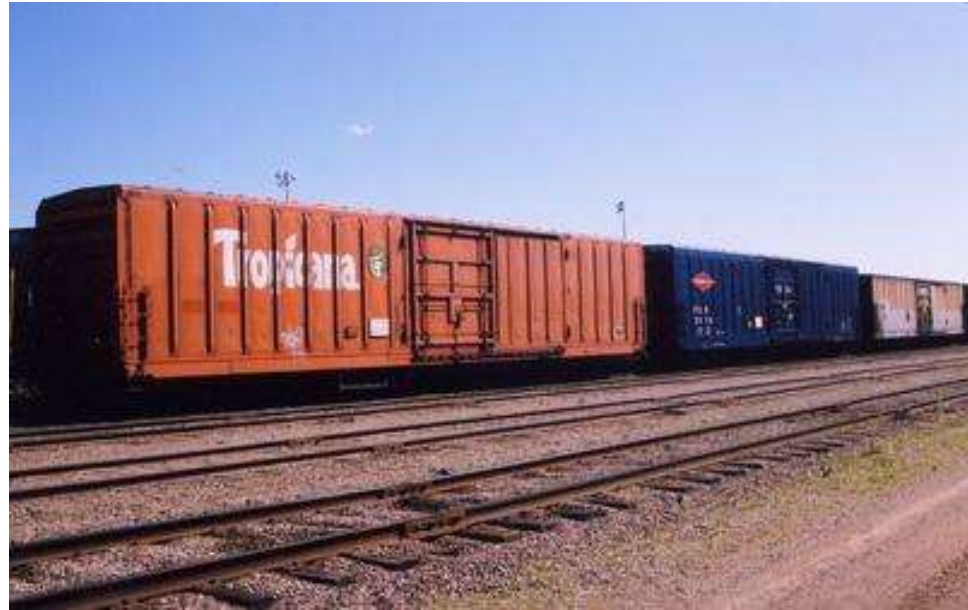
The Ark was taller than a 3-story building and had a deck area the size of 36 lawn tennis courts. Its length was 300 cubits (450 feet, or 135 meters); its width was 50 cubits (75 feet, or 22.5 meters); it had three stories and its height was 30 cubits (45 feet, or 13.5 meters).



Size of Noah's Ark

The ark's total volume would have been 1,518,000 cubic feet.

Or 569 modern railroad stock cars. This would make a train more than 5½ miles long.

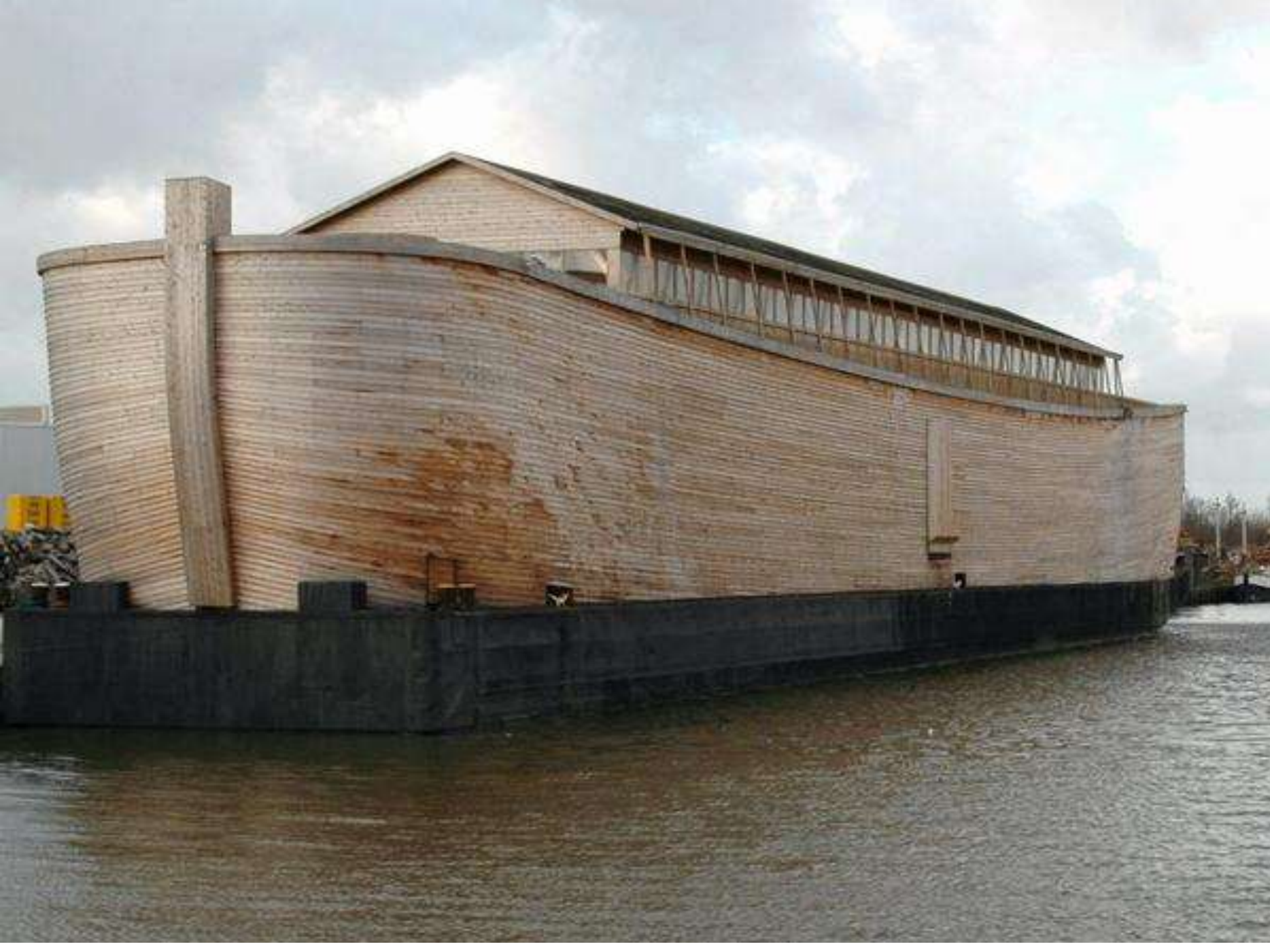
*Cross Section Of Noahs Ark * Scaled 1/96 **



40,000 animals x 11.125 ft^3 = $445,000 \text{ ft}^3$ OR
29% of the Ark's total capacity

35,000 animals x 11.125 ft^3 = $389,375 \text{ ft}^3$ OR
25% of the Ark's total capacity

16,000 animals x 11.125 ft^3 = $178,000 \text{ ft}^3$ OR
(kind = genus taxon) or 11.7%
of the Ark's total capacity

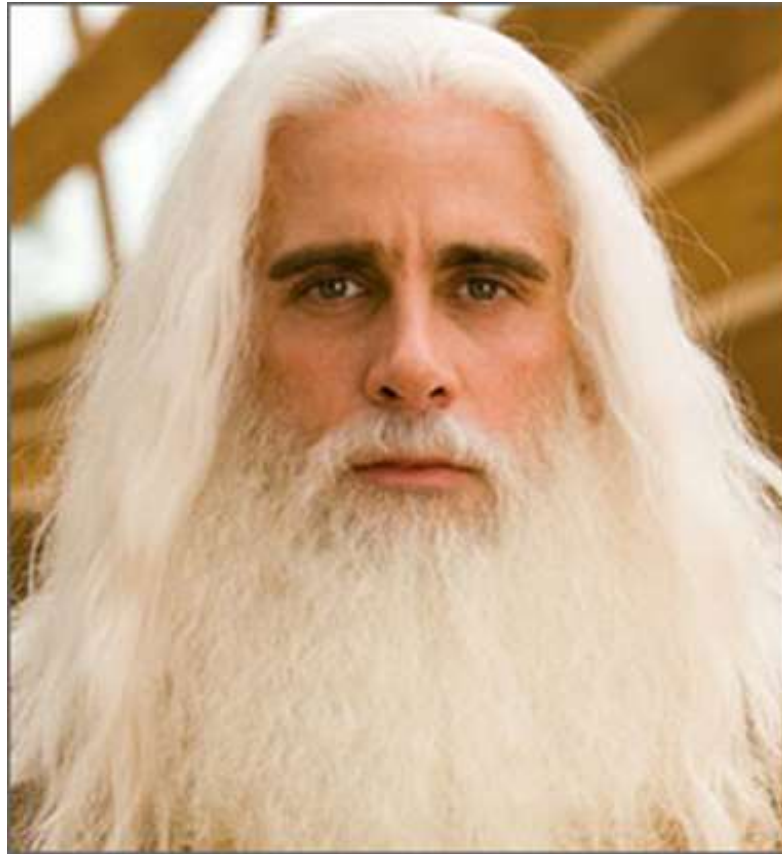
