- 16 And when the scribes and Pharisees saw Him eating with the tax collectors and sinners, they said to His disciples, "How is it that He eats and drinks with tax collectors and sinners?"




Mark 2:15-17

17 When Jesus heard it, He said to them, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick. I did not come to call the righteous, but sinners, to repentance."

But you can never repent until you let go of your own righteousness and recognize your own sinfulness.








Luke 7:36-50

Romans 5:8-10

Revelation 20:11-15

Revelation 20:11-15

13 The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.

Revelation 20:11-15 15 And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

John 14:1-6

Before a Holy God, finds no favor.




Heaven is real, so is hell,
