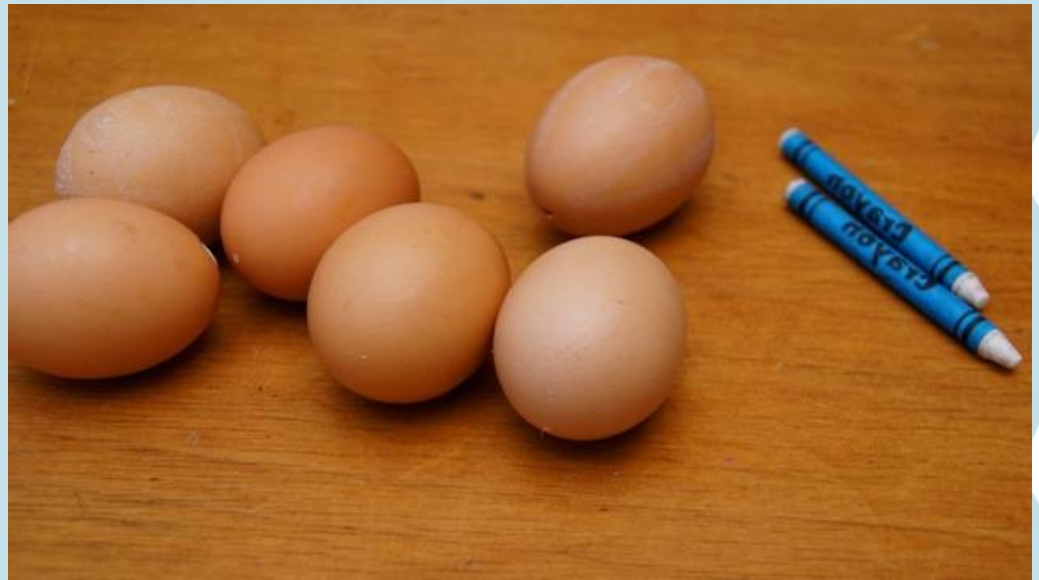
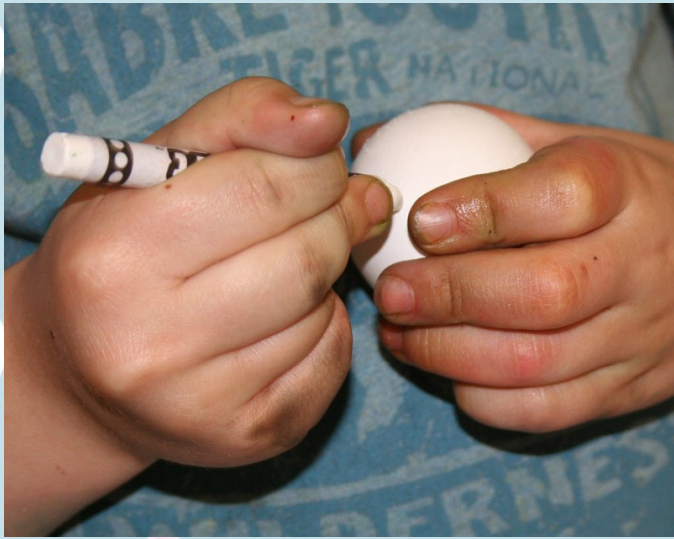
Step one:

- Hard-boil the eggs



Step two:

- When the eggs are cold, color on the eggs with white crayon



Also...

- You can use rubber bands to make a design

Step three:

- Make the dye! Mix water, vinegar, and color





Step four:

- Dip the eggs in different color dyes



Don't forget...

- If you put the egg in the dye for a long time, the color will be dark
- If you put the egg in the dye for a short time, the color will be light



Step five:

- Put the eggs into the carton to dry



All the eggs look different!

- Each egg has different colors and designs!
