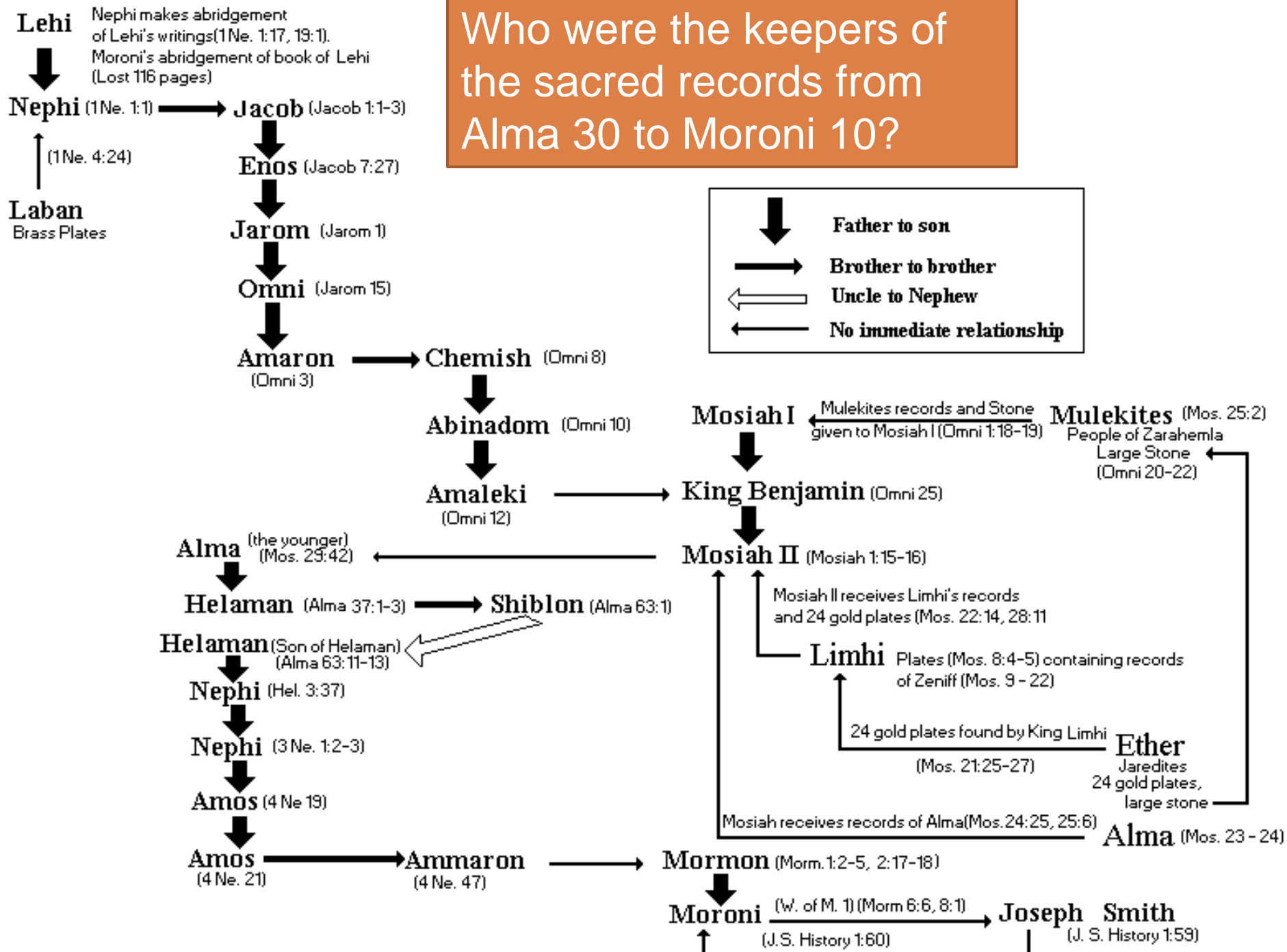
Important People to Know

- ❖ Alma- prophet, gives up judgment seat, missionary to Zoramites
- Zeezrom- missionary companion
- Ammon- in Jershon
- Korihor- anti-Christ
- Amulek- companion to Alma
- ❖ Helaman, son of Alma- prophet, not taken on mission to Jaredites, keeps records
- ❖ Shiblon- son of Alma, missionary
- Corianton- son of Alma, given into immorality- receives instruction to help him repent
- Captain Moroni- military leader, defends liberty against Amalickiah
- Amalickiah- seeks to be king, opposes Helaman (chief judge) and Moroni, threatens to drink his blood
- Teancum- slays Amalickiah and Ammoron
- Nephihah- chief judge after Alma the Younger (Alma 4); dies in chapter 50
- Pahoran- chief judge after Nephihah; has son by the same name who dies quickly
- Pacumeni- brother of Pahoran that dies quickly; also dies quickly
- Kishkumen- kills Pahoran; plots to kill Helaman, son of Helaman and is slain.
- Gadianton- jerk (head of robber band/ secret combination)
- ❖ Helaman, son of Helaman- chief judge, is almost murdered by Kishkumen, father of Nephi and Lehi
- ❖ Nephi, son of Helaman- Nephite missionary, sealing power, praying on tower for his people

Important People to Know

- Lehi, son of Helaman- younger brother of Nephi
- Samuel, the Lamanite- prophet
- ❖ Nephi, son of Nephi- one of Nephite disciples, raises brother (Timothy) from the dead
- Lachoneus- chief judge
- Giddianhi- governor of secret combination after the coming of Christ; is slain
- Gidgiddoni- military leader with spirit of prophecy and revelation
- ❖ Ammaron- gives records and task to translate to Mormon
- ❖ Mormon- abridger of Large plates and compiler of Book of Mormon
- Brother of Jared- first Jaredite prophet, led “choice land” of Americas on barges, has vision of past, present, and future with Urim and Thummim
- Ether- last Jaredite prophet, calls people unto repentance
- Coriantumr- king in the days of Ether, battles with Shiz, repents, last Jaredite survivor
- Shiz- led army against Coriantumr
- ❖ Moroni- flees the wicked, abridges the Jaredite record and seals the book of Mormon

What is meant by the phrase that the people had "all things in common" in 4 Nephi?

The Law of Consecration – where all is given to the church and a stewardship is given to the people according to their needs; where what a person needs is all they will want. Is a condition of Zion, where people choose not to give in to the selfish temptations of Satan.

What are the Lord's decrees about the Americas?

3 Nephi 20:

- ❑ These lands (New Jerusalem) are a fulfillment of the promises He made to Jacob, Moses, Samuel and those that follow, and Abraham.
- ❑ Israel will be gathered, and the Lord will provide His protection and “consecrate their gain.”
- ❑ If His people do not remain repentant, “the sword of my justice... shall fall upon them.”

Ether 2:

- ❑ Given a choice land, above all other lands; inhabitants shall be “free from bondage, and from captivity, and from all other nations under Heaven.”
- ❑ Must serve God, repent, or be destroyed by “the fullness of the wrath of God.”

Notes

Large Plates of Nephi

Made about 590 B.C. soon after arrival at the promised land (see 1 Nephi 19:1–2). Used mainly for secular history until small plates of Nephi were filled in the days of Amaleki (see Omni 1:30); thereafter they were used for both secular and religious history.

Small Plates of Nephi

Made about 570 B.C. (see 2 Nephi 5:28–32). Contain the religious history of the Nephite people from Nephi to Amaleki. The Words of Mormon were later added when the small plates of Nephi were included with the plates of Mormon (see Words of Mormon 1:1, 5).

Plates of Mormon

Called plates of Mormon because Mormon made them with his own hands (see 3 Nephi 5:10–20). It should be noted that Mormon's own little book written on the plates of Mormon is his abridgment of the more extensive account of his life and times that he wrote earlier on the large plates of Nephi (see Mormon 1:4, 2:17–18, 5:9).

What does Moroni tell us about spiritual gifts?

- All gifts are given through the Spirit. Include, but not limited to:
 - ▣ Teach the word of wisdom
 - ▣ Teach the word of knowledge
 - ▣ Faith
 - ▣ Healing
 - ▣ Miracles
 - ▣ Prophecy
 - ▣ Angels and ministering spirits
 - ▣ Tongues
 - ▣ Interpretation of languages
- “Every good gift cometh of Christ”
- “If there be one among you that doeth good, he shall work by the power and gifts of God.”

Where will the New Jerusalem be built? By whom?

- Where: The Americas “For it is wisdom in the Father that they should be established *in this land*, and be set up as a free people by the power of the Father, that these things might come forth from them unto a remnant of your seed, that the covenants of the Father may be fulfilled which he hath covenanted with his people, O house of Israel;”
- Who: The Saints; those that remain loyal to the covenant “Therefore, when these works and the works which shall be wrought among you hereafter shall come forth from *the Gentiles*, unto your seed which shall dwindle in unbelief because of iniquity.”
