12:13 Then someone from the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me." 12:14 But Jesus said to him, "Man, who made me a judge or arbitrator between you two?" 12:15 Then he said to them, "Watch out and guard yourself from all types of greed, because one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." 12:16 He then told them a parable: "The land of a certain rich man produced an abundant crop, 12:17 so he thought to himself, 'What should I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?'



- If you aren't careful you may end up thinking the money is the solution to all of life's difficulties.



- Whatever you worship is your God. Luke 12:34


