Matt 6:28-30

- 28) And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:
- **29)** And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- **30)** Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into

the oven, *shall he* not much more *clothe* you, O ye of little faith?

Consider the lilies- NOT Admire the lilies
Enjoy the lilies
Praise the lilies...

God is not interested in you getting a B.A. in botany

Mere head knowledge of God's word gives you a B.A. in Bible- bad attitude

Consider... how they grow-Mysteriously. 'How they grow.'

The lilies are proof of the *Gardner skill*.


Unlike human gardeners-God is responsible

I. Germination stage-

The seed is the safest stage of this future flower

GERMINATION- THE SEED SAFETY STAGE

Phil 3:1

Finally,

my brethren, rejoice in the Lord.

To write the same things to you, to me indeed *is* not grievous,

but for you it is safe.

Finally-

Not a conclusion but, a highlight of a salient point.

Usually Paul will follow the "finally" with how to instruction

It is Safe- (rejoicing in the Lord)

Phil 3:20-21

- 20) For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:
- 21) Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body,

according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

Rejoice, a much used command

- ...thou shalt rejoice before the LORD thy God in all that thou puttest thine hands unto.



Standing strong

Bud- Stand/Strong Stage Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved. 100% of the time Phil 4:1 • Passively -Phil 4:6-7 = the peace of God -Phil 4:8-9 = the God of peace

Passive

Phil 4:6-7

- 6) Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.
- 7) And the **peace of God**, which passeth all understanding,

shall keep your <u>hearts and minds</u> through Christ Jesus.

Phil 4:8-9

8) Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things *are* honest, whatsoever things *are* just,


