



<u>ABRAHAM</u>

- Father of the Jewish people
- Father of faith due his assent to the Will of God and His Justice
- Spiritually, the father and ancestor of all true believers
- Recognized by the Apostles as a sign of the resurrection of mankind the Savior, Jesus Christ
- "Abram" was his original name which means "The father is exalted"



God's Promises to Abraham:

1) Land – Gen. 13:14-15 2) Descendants – Gen. 22:17 > 3) Blessing for all nations – Gen. 22:18 (since he is the ancestor of **Jesus Christ**)

Realizations During Abraham's Life:


1) <u>About God</u> - always takes

- protector of those who are faithful and obedient to Him




Realizations During Abraham's Life:

- that faith means also "concern" for one's fellow human beings




The Elements of True Faith:

 Obedience




Abrahams' Relations

- Terah the father of Abraham
- <u>Abraham's Brothers:</u>
- > 1. Haran
- 2. Nahor
- Sarah the wife of Abraham
- her name means "princess"
- originally named "Sarai"
- Hagar the Egyptian maidservant of Sarah
- bore Abraham's first son lshmael




Abrahams' Relations

- Ishmael the name means "God Heard"
- Isaac the name means " He Laughs"
- the legitimate son of Abraham and Sarah
- the bearer of the Promise
- was asked by God to be offered as a holocaust or human sacrifice from Abraham
- the secondary figure as link to Abraham and Jacob




- <u>Rebekah</u> the wife of Isaac who was barren
- the daughter of Bethuel and the sister of Laban
- Esau "the hairy one"
- the firstborn son and one of the twins of Isaac and Rebekah
- had reddish skin and a hairy body
- sold his birthright to Jacob for a pot of lentils




- Jacob (Jakub) the name means "one who takes the heel" or "God Protects"
- > the twin brother of Esau
- deceived Isaac to render his blessing that was meant for Esau who is firstborn
- was renamed "Israel" which means "the strong one of God"
- became the husband and father of the sons of the sisters Leah and Rachel
- became also the father of the sons of the <u>Bilhah</u> and <u>Zilpah</u>, maid-servants of Rachel and Leah respectively



- The 12 Tribes of Israel (12 Sons of Jacob):

- Judah
- Isaachar
- Zebulun Leah
- Joseph
 <u>Benjamin</u> <u>Mother:</u>
 <u>Rachel</u>
- > Dan
- <u>Napthali</u> <u>Mother:</u> <u>Bilhah (Rachel's maid)</u>
- Gad
- Asher Mother: Zilpah (Leah's maid)



- Joseph the name means "let God add"
- one of the sons of Jacob
- envied by his brothers since he was Jacob's favorite son in his old age and was gifted with a multicolored coat
- was sold by his brothers to slave traders but made to believe to Jacob that he was killed

- became the governor of Egypt and there became a numerous people
