1. King Xerxes

- In the 3rd year of a 21 yr reign
- Rules over the vast Persian Empire

2. Queen Vashti

- Not a great deal known
- Strong minded/independent-thinking

3. Haman – 'the bad guy'

- Next in line to the king
- Arrogant/deceitful/anti-Semitic

4. Mordecai – 'the good guy'

- Jew still residing in Persia
- Godly man plays a significant role in Esther's life

5. Esther

- Name means 'star'
- Young & stunningly beautiful
- Destined to become Queen

Synopsis of events in chapter 1

- Banquet 1 for military leaders, nobles
 & officials lasting 180 days
- Banquet 2 for all the people lasting 7 days
- Banquet 3 for 'women only' hosted by Vashti

Synopsis of events in chapter 1

- Xerxes commands Vashti to provide entertainment for his guests
- She refuses Xerxes is fuming
- Vacancy for position of Queen Beauty contest is planned

On the seventh day, when King Xerxes was in high spirits from wine, he commanded the seven eunuchs who served him ... to bring before him Queen Vashti ... to display her beauty to the people ... for she was lovely to look at. But ..., Queen Vashti refused to come. Then the king became furious and burned with anger

Mordecai had a cousin ... whom he had brought up because she had neither father nor mother. This girl, who was also known as Esther, was lovely in form and features, and Mordecai had taken her as his own daughter when her father and mother died
