Leaven is like yeast. It is a noun and a verb - It is and it does.


It's characteristic impacts and acts everything around.

A little for a lot. It is:


- Smoothly distributed

They need to spread out, not clump together for better influence.


SMOOTHLY DISTRIBUTED
