⁷The Lord God formed the man (Adam) from the soil (Heb. haadama) of the ground


and breathed into his nostrils

¹⁰ Now a river flows from Eden to water the orchard, and from there it divides into four headstreams. 11 The name of the first is Pishon; it runs through the entire land of Havilah, where there is gold. 12 (The gold of that land is pure; pearls and lapis lazuli are also there). 13 The name of the second river is Gihon; it runs through the entire land of Cush. 14 The name of the third river is Tigris; it runs along the east side of Assyria. The fourth river is the and delta visible in Euphrates.



The conditional covenant

¹⁶Then the Lord God

commanded the man,

"You may freely eat fruit from every tree of the orchard,

he took part of the man's side and closed up the place with flesh.




The ideal partner is perceived as an equal.


Genesis 2:23 (NET)
