Prophesying: It is the special ability to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to His people through a divinely-anointed utterance.

Service: The gift of serving is an ability to perform practical tasks related to the work of the Lord. A person who serves helps others accomplish spiritual goals by freeing them from routine but necessary duties

Teaching: is the God given desire, ability and power to examine and study God's word and help others understand and apply it.

Romans 12:6-8

Encouragement: God given desire, ability and power to uplift others and inspire them to trust God. Delivering God's word in a way that it touches the heart, consciences and the will of the hearer

Giving: is the God given desire, ability and power of one who has the financial or material resources to give freely so that others needs are met and God's work is advanced


Leadership: is the ability given by the Spirit to help set a course of direction and unify people for the accomplishment of God's work

Gifts of The Holy Spirit 1 Corinthians 12: 7-11



The word of wisdom is the ability to receive insight as to how knowledge may be applied to specific needs.



The word of knowledge is the ability to understand things which others do not know and cannot comprehend and to share this knowledge with them under the inspiration of the Spirit.

Gift of Faith A person with the gift of faith has a special ability to believe with supernatural confidence and trust God in difficult circumstances.

Gifts of The Holy Spirit 1 Corinthians 12: 7-11



A believer with the gifts of healing has the ability to let God's power flow through him to restore health apart from the use of natural methods.

Gift of Miracles Through a person with the gift of miracles God performs powerful acts which are beyond the possibility of occurring naturally...

Gift of Discerning of Spirits Discerning of spirits is the ability to evaluate people, doctrines, and situations as to whether they are of God or of Satan..



Gifts of The Holy Spirit 1 Corinthians 12: 7-11



The gift of tongues is the ability to receive and communicate a message of God to His people through a language never learned. "Tongues" means languages.

Gift of interpretation of tongues The gift of interpretation is a special ability to make known in a language understood the message of one who speaks in tongues.

Prophesying

It is the special ability to receive and communicate an immediate message of God to His people through a divinelyanointed utterance.

1 Corinthians 12: 27-31; Eph 4:11

Apostles: the ability to pioneer ministries and provide spiritual leadership over a number of churches that result in fruitful ministry

Administration: A person with the gift of administration has the ability to give direction, organize, and make decisions on behalf of others

Help: A person with the gift of helps has the ability to assist others in the work of the Lord enabling them to increase the effectiveness of their own spiritual gifts

> *Evangelist:* An evangelist has a special ability to share the Gospel with nonbelievers in a way that men and women respond and become responsible members of the Body of Christ.

Pastor :The pastor assumes the responsibility of the spiritual welfare of God's people. The word pastor literally means shepherd, one who looks out for a flock

1 Peter 4:9

 21. Hospitality (veivuke): The gift of hospitality is a special ability God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to provide food and lodging for those in need. A requirement for the use of this spiritual gift is that it is done without grudging. Grudging means resenting having to do it.

1 Peter 4:7-11 Are you a Thief?

- If we don't use our gifts, we fail to obey God. If we fail to step out and do so, there are three results:
- 1. You rob yourself of being in God's will. (vs.10)
- 2. You rob the <u>body of Christ of the benefits of that</u> gift (vs.10)
- 3. You rob God of the glory He deserves (vs.11)

Steps to Discover and **Develop Your Gifts** 1. Explore the possibilities 2. Experiment as much as possible 3. Examine how you feel 4. Evaluate your effectiveness 5. Expect confirmation from the **Body of Christ**



Gentleness & Self Control

- seeks the best possible good for the individual being love
- sacrificially meeting the needs of others

- Patient
- Kind
- Does not envy
- Does not Boast
- It is not Proud

- act of the will and not necessarily of the emotion
- best description of the practical outworking of love in a believer's life is given in 1 Cor 13:4-7

It is not rude It is not self seeking Not easily angered

- It keeps no record of wrongs
- Does not delight in evil but rejoices with truth
- Protects, trust, Hopes, Perseveres

Agape Love: it is the love that seeks no revenge, enables us to love the unlovable, unconditional love

Love

approximately 70 times in NT

- deep inward satisfaction that is not dependent on circumstances
- an inner rejoicing that can manifest itself in all circumstances because it rests on God's control over all things
- unmoved by sorrow, tribulations and trials
- Paul used this word frequently in the book of Philippians

Peace

- opposite of anxiety is "peace"
- a heart that is tranquil because it knows God is in charge
- a positive state of "wholeness,"
 "soundness," and "prosperity
- opposite of "disorder" or "confusion"
- it defies description (Phil. 4:7).

Patience

- endurance
- •Perseverance
- •Ability to wait without becoming angry, annoyed, or upset

•Ability to tolerate being hurt, or provoked without losing one's temper

Kindness

- Involves true and active consideration for others
- It includes not wanting to hurt anyone or cause any one pain

Goodness

- ✤ generosity
- gentleness in action
- doing good to others even when they do not deserve it
- Is a character trait that causes someone to do what is right and beneficial to others

Faithfulness

- synonyms for
 "faithfulness" are dependable, reliable, and trustworthy
- refers to a life that is consistent and always can be counted upon
- one of the characteristics of our God (1 Cor 1:9; 10:13; 1 Thess 5:24; 2 Tim 2:13; 1 John 1:9).

Gentleness

- ✓ Submission to the will of God
- ✓ Teachableness
- ✓ Being considerate
- ✓ it refers to a strong man who has surrender to God and therefore has his strength under control

Self Control

- ✓ refers to discipline in all areas of life, especially moral
- relates to the curbing of fleshly desires and impulses
- a life that is under the control of the individual because the individual is under the control of the Holy Spirit
