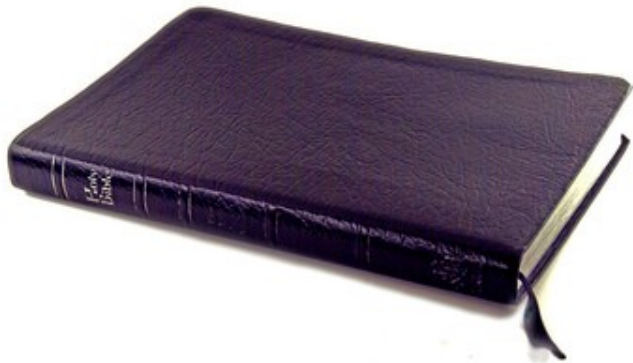
- Leper (8:2-4): Contagious disease

Debilitating disease



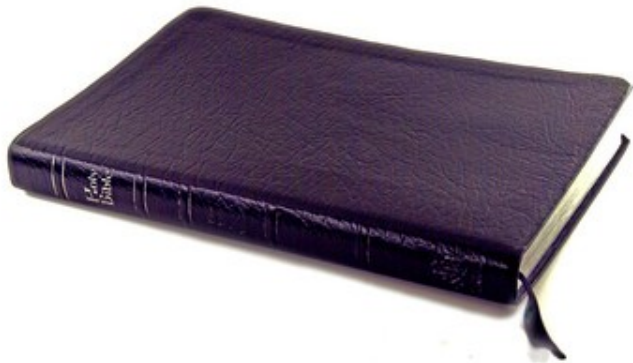
- Peter's wife's mother (8:14-15):

Demon possession.

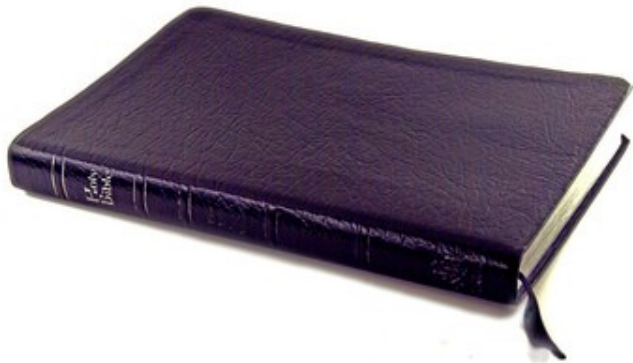


- Man sick of palsy (9:1-8):
