






John 4:1-3

- ¹ The Pharisees heard that Jesus was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John,
- ² although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples.
- ³ When the Lord learned of this, he left Judea and went back once more to Galilee.

⁵ So he came to a town in Samaria called Sychar, near the plot of ground Jacob had given to his son Joseph.

⁶ Jacob's well was there, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about the sixth hour.


Jn 4:7-9









2 Kings 17:6 In the ninth year of Hoshea, the king of Assyria captured Samaria and deported the Israelites to Assyria. He settled them in Halah, in Gozan on the Habor River and in the towns of the Medes.



2 Kings 17:24 The king of Assyria brought people from Babylon, Cuthah, Avva, Hamath and Sepharvaim and settled them in the towns of Samaria to replace the Israelites. They took over Samaria and lived in its towns.





Samaritans

- Intermarried with non-Jews
- Only accept 1 prophet -Moses
- Only accept the Torah (Gen to Deut) & Joshua
- Holy Place Mount Gerizim



Jews

- No inter-marrying with non-Jews
- Torah plus the Writings, Psalms & Prophets
- Holy Place Jerusalem Mount





2. Barriers to Break

- b) <u>Gender Barrier</u>
 - At that time men do not talk to women in public
 - NOT EVEN to own wife, sister or daughter in public
 - Esp so for a religious rabbi

eg "blue & black Rabbis"


- ¹⁶ He told her, "Go, call your husband and come back."



⁴¹ And because of his words many more became believers.

⁴² They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."
