Jesus, not just a distant historical character but someone who is alive today, looking for a personal relationship with you.


Jesus, not just a voice to hear but a person to get to know.

- 3 Judah the father of Perez and Zerah, whose mother was Tamar, Perez the father of Hezron, Hezron the father of Ram,
- 4 Ram the father of Amminadab, Amminadab the father of Nahshon, Nahshon the father of Salmon,

5 Salmon the father of Boaz, whose mother was Rahab, Boaz the father of Obed, whose mother was Ruth, Obed the father of Jesse,


¹⁶ and Jacob the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary, and Mary was the mother of Jesus who is called the Messiah


- ³⁰ Lot and his two daughters left Zoar and settled in the mountains, for he was afraid to stay in Zoar. He and his two daughters lived in a cave.

- ³² Let's get our father to drink wine and then sleep with him and preserve our family line through our father."
- ³³ That night they got their father to drink wine, and the older daughter went in and slept with him. He was not aware of it when she lay down or when she got up.

- She fell pregnant. (2 Sam 11:4).
- David plans to have her husband, his friend murdered. (2 Sam 11:14 In the morning David wrote a letter to Joab and sent it with Uriah. 15 In it he wrote, "Put Uriah out in front where the fighting is fiercest. Then withdraw from him so he will be struck down and die.")




Solomon

- A child of iniquity.





- Under her (Naamah's) influence Rehoboam (when he came to power) digressed from the true religion.
- Rehoboam encouraged apostacy.
 - Idolatry became the prevailing form of state worship.
 - "the religious state of the kingdom in his reign is described by the high places, the idolatrous statues, the groves and impure rites that with unchecked license were observed in them. The description is suited to the character of the Canaanitish worship."

El	The creator and father of the gods.
Ashtoret	(Athirat)the consort of El and mother of the gods
Anat	The goddess of love, sensuality and war. Baal's wife and sister. Wears a necklace of human heads
Yamm	The sea. He is regarded in the Baal myth as one of Baal's major adversaries.
Mot	His name means "death". He was god of the underworld.
Resheph	Pestilence. One of the most popular gods worshipped in Egypt.
Baal-Haddad	A warrior god. War-like god. A dying and rising fertility god. Baal was also referred to as "rider of the clouds".






