




What is LOVE?

The Four Loves

Storge - Affection

• Affection (storge, στοργή) is fondness through familiarity (a brotherly love), especially between family members or people who have otherwise found themselves together by chance.

Philia - Friendship


• Philia (Greek: mulia) is the love between friends. Friendship is the strong bond existing between people who share common interest or activity.

Eros - Romance

• Eros (ἔρως) love in the sense of being in love' or 'loving' someone

Agape - Unconditional Love

• Charity (agapē, ἀγάπη) is the love that brings forth caring regardless of the circumstance. Lewis recognizes this as the greatest of loves, and sees it as a specifically Christian virtue.
