







1 Chronicles 4:10 NIV


Does Jabez' prayer sound selfish to you?




Does his prayer sound to you like a prayer for material or spiritual blessings?




Do you think Jabez' final request was to avoid experiencing pain personally, or to avoid causing pain to others?





Jabez' Prayer – 1 Chr. 4:10

GNB "Bless me, God, and give me much land. Be with me and keep me from anything evil that might cause me pain."

HCSB "If only You would bless me, extend my border, let Your hand be with me, and keep me from harm, so that I will not cause any pain."

If only You would bless me

 Jacob, his distant grandfather, had done much the same thing



James 1:17 NIV

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. (6) But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

Extend my border

- A favorite of modern readers
 - -GNB "give me much land."
 - -NIV "enlarge my territory!"
 - -HCSB "extend my border"

Matthew 19:23-24 NIV

Then Jesus said to his disciples, "I tell you the truth, it is hard for a rich man to enter the kingdom of heaven. (24) Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God."

1 Timothy 6:9-11 NIV

People who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into ruin and destruction. (10) For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.

1 Timothy 6:9-11 NIV

Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. (11) But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.

(11) Obey what I command you today. I will drive out before you the Amorites, Canaanites, Hittites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites. (12) Be careful not to make a treaty with those who live in the land where you are going, or they will be a snare among you.

Exodus 34:23-24 NIV

Three times a year all your men are to appear before the Sovereign LORD, the God of Israel. (24) I will drive out nations before you and enlarge your territory, and no one will covet your land when you go up three times each year to appear before the LORD your God.

This is about God's promise

- Applied to Jabez' day:
 - -Not about personal enrichment
 - Prayer to exterminate idolatry that dishonored God
- Applied to today:
 - -Not personal enrichment
 - —Prayer to expand Christ's kingdom

1 Peter 4:10-11 NIV

Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. (11) If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God.

1 Peter 4:10-11 NIV

If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.

Let Your hand be with me

- Jabez prays for a constant sense of God's abiding presence
- Adopts Moses' prayer for ancestor, Judah, and Judah's descendants (Deut. 33:7 ESV)

2 Corinthians 13:14 NIV

May the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

Hebrews 13:5-6 NIV

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." (6) So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?"

Keep me from evil, so that I will not cause any pain

- GNB "keep me from anything evil that might cause me pain"
- HCSB "keep me from harm, so that I will not cause any pain."

Keep me from evil

Galatians 1:4 NLT Jesus gave His life for our sins, just as God our Father planned, in order to rescue us from this evil world in which we live.

Romans 13:7-10 NIV Give everyone what you owe him: If you owe taxes, pay taxes; if revenue, then revenue; if respect, then respect; if honor, then honor.

(8) Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellowman has fulfilled the law.

(9) The commandments, "Do not commit adultery," "Do not murder," "Do not steal," "Do not covet," and whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this one rule: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

(10) Love does no harm to its neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law.

James 4:1-3 NIV

What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don't they come from your desires that battle within you? (2) You want something but don't get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight.

James 4:1-3 NIV

You do not have, because you do not ask God. (3) When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures.

God Granted His Request

- Epilogue makes the prayer of Jabez so popular and promising
- We want what we want and Jabez got what he asked for, so we figure we will ask the same way

A good model, if understood

- It is not the greedy, rote mantra into which men have tried to transform it
- James 5:16 NLT The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results.
- Prayer is not Get Rich Quick Plan
