

Hebrews 11:5-6

⁵ By faith Enoch was taken away so that he did not see death, "and was not found, because God had taken him"; for before he was taken he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

⁶ But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him,* for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Genesis 5:21-24

- 21 Enoch lived sixty-five years, and begot Methuselah.
- 22 After he begot Methuselah, Enoch walked with God three hundred years, and had sons and daughters.
- 23 So all the days of Enoch were three hundred and sixty-five years.
- 24 And Enoch walked with God; and he was not, for God took him.

Initiated; initiating; teacher; dedicated; consecrated

 6:9; 10:1; 11:10; 11:27; 25:12; 25:19; 36:1; 36:9;
 37:2)
- Genesis 5:1 "This is the book of the generations of Adam."
- Matthew 1:1 "The book of the generation of Jesus Christ."





B. TRANSLATION - to carry across, to bear up, to remove, to change from one place to another;


