Judges 4:1-10

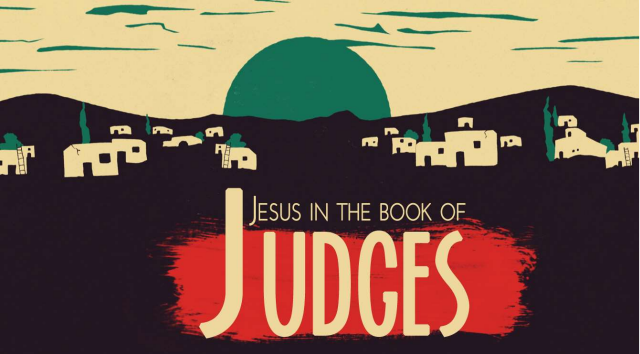


The Cycle of Judges



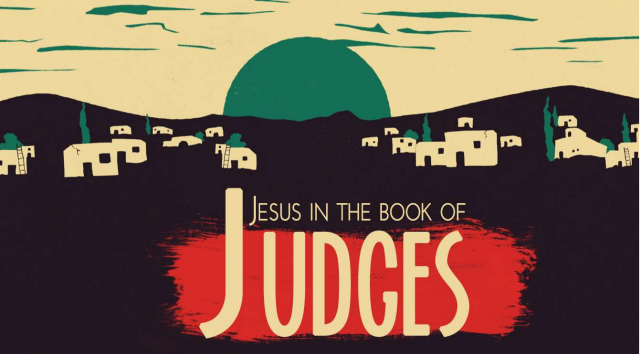
When new gods
